THE MEETING OF THE 75C DITCH WAS CALLED TO ORDER AT 7:10 P.M. AT THE SALMON PUBLIC LIBRARY.

THERE WERE 9 MEMBERS PRESENT.

MR. LARRY WEEKS, FROM THE FISH AND GAME DEPARTMENT WAS IN ATTENDANCE. HE PRESENTED US WITH THE PROPOSED CHANGES THAT WOULD BE MADE TO THE HEAD OF THE DITCH, IF WE DECIDE TO COMBINE OUR DITCH WITH THE POPE DITCH. THERE IS A SHOW ME TRIP TO CHALLIS TOMORROW, MARCH 7, TO SHOW US HOW THIS COMBINATION OF TWO DITCHES WOULD WORK. FRED JAKOVAC AND DALE DUTTON ARE GOING AND WILL REPORT BACK TO US. WE QUESTIONED AS TO HOW THIS WILL EFFECT OUR WATER RIGHTS BOTH FEDERAL AND STATE. WE WILL ALSO LOOK AT THE FACT THAT 75C'S WATER IS DECREED AND POPE DITCH IS NOT. WILL EACH DITCH HAVE THERE OWN SPILL WAY TO RETURN EXCESS WATER TO THE RIVER AS WE DO NOW.

IT WAS REPORTED THAT 2 LETTERS FROM WORK MANS COMP HAVE BEEN RECEIVE INFORMING US THAT WE ARE REQUIRED TO HAVE WORK MANS COMP ON EMPLOYEES.  
THE SECRETARY WILL CONTACT WORK MANS COMP ON THIS MATTER.

IT WAS VOTED ON THAT A 10% ANNUAL FEE WILL BE PLACED ON ALL OVERDO ASSESSMENTS. ALL PAST DUE ACCOUNTS WILL HAVE A CLAIM OF LIEN FILED AT THE COURT HOUSE SO THEY WILL HAVE TO BE PAID BEFORE THEIR PROPERTY CAN BE SOLD.
