The minutes of the 1999 meeting were read and accepted as read

Opening statement: Today we have no water master present. A lot of the information needed for this meeting we do not have because he is not present with the information. Are there any other suggestions on this? Should give Hank a call and get the information together.

Is there someone from the advisory committee to take up? Steve Dobson said from my understanding it was Jack Fry, ~~Double~~<sup>DOVE</sup> and I. Each year you need to reelect another advisory committee. We have a motion to elect an advisory committee. Do we have a second motion? Margaret Drake has made the motion and the second by Steve Dobson to elect a new advisory committee with nominations and volunteers. We have three volunteers for the advisory committee; we have J.C. Fry, Margaret Drake and Cliff Bledsoe. Margaret Drake does not have any Porter creek water rights; she is welcome to be here but cannot be on the advisory committee. Since Margaret Drake has no Porter Creek water rights, J.C. Fry, Cliff Bledsoe and Lynn Gramkow have been elected. All in favor, I, appose, none.

Hank Berstein was re nominated for Water Master. The advisory committee will contact Hank Berstein to see if he will still be available to be the Water Master. The advisory committee needs to get the information on the budget. After they receive the budget they will take it up in association with Steve Lester. Steve said in the budget theirs roughly \$1900.00 based on last year's data. There is no additional assessments needed, that's kind of sitting steady. You could adopt that as your budget with no new assessments since we don't have any other information. The adopted budget from this meeting needs to go to the department of the county. And a copy needs to be given to the secretary and

go from there. We move that we adopt the budget for \$1900.00 for the year 2000 with no further assessments for this year. The motion was made. All in favor, I, appose, none.

New Business: Steve Lester said the status of the <sup>Adjudication</sup> jurisdiction for your area here the main stem of the Payette and all the Porter Creek and the work that is going on to summarize all those water rights, Porter Creek, Payette river, and the directors report which would be the summary of recommendations of those rights. It's scheduled to be done in August or so this year. So that means this year is supposed to be the year in which all of the right developed by 1987 will be recommended to by the court and then jurisdiction. So you might be receiving some phone calls or letters from Porter Creek or other Water Rights. There will be plenty of chances for you to look at any recommendations the department is going to make? When you have a Water Right if its decreed and what not, when the department recommends what they believe the water right is they first send those recommendations to you to claim them and then theirs a 60 day period or something like that, to point out any thing that they don't think is correct. The court will make the final decision. What about the courtesy rights? Are they going to be confirmed? My best bet they will probably recommend it to be disallowed, meaning they wont hold any water rights so to speak. I don't know it's just a guess.

Group was advised the next meeting would be the first Wednesday in March 2001. Place meeting will be held at the Long Branch.

There will be no further business to discuss meeting was adjourned.
