On June 5, 1996, the Department issued a prehearing order in the matter of the petition of McCammon Ditch Co. for administration of water within Water District 29. The order stayed any proceeding until August 30, 1996. The order also stated that after August 30, 1996, the department would determine if further informal proceedings are appropriate, or whether it should schedule formal proceedings to resolve the dispute.

As of this date, the department has not been contacted by any of the parties identified in the petition. The department also is not aware if any parties have contacted each other in regard to this matter. The department had anticipated that the parties might contact each other prior to August 30 and provide some further information to the department regarding how to proceed with the petition.

The department asks at this time that you contact this office on or before October 30 regarding the McCammon petition. If no response is provided by October 30, the department will proceed to schedule a second prehearing conference.

We also wish to advise you that the department has contacted the Portneuf-Marsh Valley Canal Co. about completing the necessary field work for the Chesterfield Reservoir survey. The field work will be conducted by department staff during the week of October 7, 1996.
