SUBJECT: Stoppage of Water Delivery Due To Faulty Measuring Device

Today I talked to the watermaster of District 47-0, Rock Creek. The district has decided to stop delivering water to Ken Mulberry until he replaces an inaccurate measuring device. They will finish off his deliveries for this year, but will not give him water after that until he fixes the problem. What he needs to do is to replace and inadequate weir with a Parshall flume, and to fix his headgate so it doesn't leak. You previously wrote to Mulberry warning him about the possibility of being cut off, but he has been totally uncooperative. The district wants to give him plenty of notice so that he can plan ahead for next year.

The watermaster didn't think he had the authority to stop deliveries on his own, so has asked me how to proceed. Will the Director issue an order to Mulberry in this matter, or should we proceed some other way? Mulberry's address is c/o Russet Valley Produce, Kimberly, ID, 83341.
