Dear Mr. Seamons:

I wish to verify that I have received your letter dated April 21, 1994 on behalf of Devil Creek Ranch. I also wish to inform you that I contacted Jack Eastman last night and instructed him to deliver Devil Creek Ranch's Deadwood Creek right. Mr. Eastman indicated that he would make every effort to deliver the right to Devil Creek Ranch today.

You should be aware that delivery of the full 3.0 cfs to your client depends on availability of water in Deadwood Creek. During my field visit a week ago, the flow in Devil Creek above the Cedar Mesa diversion appeared to be less than 3.0 cfs. I suspect that the warm weather in the past week has increased the runoff in Deadwood Creek and that it may now be possible to deliver the full 3.0 cfs.
