
Annual Meeting of Water District 37U Fish Creek for the election of a Water Master and the adoption of a budget for the year 1994. Held at the Carey School Library. March 7, 1994 at 10 A.M.


Meeting was called to order by chairman Shirl Reay. Mr. Doug Jones represented the Dept. of Water Resources at the meeting. Nominations were called for for chairman. Jim Sarratt nominated Shirl Reay. Shirl Was elected by a unanimous vote. Nominations were called for for Secretary and Treasurer. Robb Peck Nominated Ronald Peck. Ronald was elected by a unanimous vote. The minutes and report of income and expenses for the year 1993, and a proposed budget of \$14,844.00 for the year 1994 were read by the Secretary. Jim Sarratt moved that the minutes be approved and that the \$14,844.00 budget be adopted. Seconded by Harold Tolman. Approved unanimously.

The Chairman called for old business. Garth Cook read a letter from Don Morrow opposing the motion approved last year that prohibited pumping water into the creek and using it some other place. This was discussed. Garth presented the motion but it died for lack of a second. Gilbert Cross moved a weir be put in West Fork to measure the water on that side. This will be discussed in a Reservoir meeting later.

The method of voting was discussed. Lee Eldredge Moved we use the one man one vote system for the election of Water Master. Seconded by Harold Tolman. Passed unanimously. Nominations were called for Water Master. Jim Sarrett nominated Darla M. Tanner as Water Master with Lawrence Kimball as assistant. There were no other nominations. A unanimous ballot was cast for Darla and Lawrence.

No further business. The chairman declared the meeting adjourned.
