

11 - F *Boehme*

Minutes for the annual meeting of the F-11 Water District
Geneva, Idaho
February 13, 2013

There were no advisory board members present at the start of the meeting. The water district secretary James Teuscher took order of the meeting.

Joel Teuscher Presented the budget for the 2013 water year. He reported that the district was not able to deliver water that was billed to members of the district. Joel reported that a few people will receive credit on their bill for 2013. The credit is a total of \$700.00. There was only 79 cfs delivered in 2012. The base fee for each cfs is \$10.00. Then the estimated use fee is based on \$16.00 cfs.

Mr. Peterson asked if he received a credit because he felt he did not get all his water for the year. Joel reported that he did not receive a credit. Mr. Peterson was asked if he received a packet from the IDWR that contained information about his measuring devise. Mr. Peterson reported that he did not and Joel said he would help find that information. Joel reported that all the measuring devises were functional by the end of the water year. The water year ended earlier than expected because the water ran low. Bob Boehme asked if his culvert worked that he replaced. Joel reported that it worked.

Mr. Field is here from Rexburg to talk about the rocky mountain power irrigation energy savers efficiency alliance. Mr. Field explained what the energy savers included and how to exchange old parts for new ones. He also went over the help RMP would give for repairing pumps and pivots. The pivots would have to install a whole pivot package. Mr. Field gave use applications for the each of the programs available. He also gave use the phone number for extra help if needed.

Joel Talked about that the water masters job is to get the water to the diversion point and though the measuring devise, after that it is up to the farmer to see that the water reaches their place. Joel reported that there was problems at the hall ditch this summer. Mr. Brooks tried to reform the ditch bank to move water down the hall ditch. The advisory board sent him a letter asking him to rebuild the bank in case of high water in 2013. The other issue is that he shares the hall ditch with a couple other farmers. Mr. Brooks said they took some of his water. Mr. Brooks contacted the water master to complain. Joel told him that he delivered the water to the head gate and after that he, Mr. Brooks, needed to talk to the other farmers to work out the differences.

Joel talked about beaver dams and what we could do to about them.

The elections for advisory board members were next. The motion was made by Richard to keep the advisory board the same. It was seconded by Bill. The water master was motioned by Dustin to keep Joel Teuscher as the water master. It was seconded by Richard. The secretary was motioned to retain James Teuscher as secretary. Bill motioned and Dustin seconded the motion for secretary.

Bryce Boehme mentioned that the district try to increase the funds in the district for use in matters that might arise. He mentioned that the Ida-Mont Farms water hearing that the district petitioned last summer.
