

HOWARD GOODWIN, President and Secretary, respectively, of the Board of Directors of Squaw Creek Irrigation District, Gem County, State of Idaho, do hereby certify that the attached is the original Determination of the Board of Directors of Squaw Creek Irrigation District of the benefits which will accrue to each of the several tracts or subdivisions of land within such irrigation District from the issuance of the bonds of Squaw Creek Irrigation District in the principal amount of \$25,000.00, par or face value, as authorized by qualified electors of said district at an election held in said District on the 10th day of May, 1937, and the original list of the apportionment or distribution of such bond issue over such tracts or subdivisions in proportion to such benefits.

WE FURTHER CERTIFY, That said list contains a complete description of each tract or subdivision of land within said District, with the amount and rate per acre of such apportionment or distribution of benefits, and the name of the owner thereof, if known to said board; and that the whole amount of the assessment of benefits as set forth in said list equals the amount of such bonds authorized at said election aforesaid.
