

Finding Examples in the Idaho Model Ordinance

The required language can be found by looking at what section of the form you are in, along with the Letter found beneath "State Model". For Example, to find the "Citation of Statutory Authorization" in the Idaho Model Ordinance you use the Roman Number labeled with an "Example A" and the State Model Letter with an "Example B"; **specifically this part of the code is found in §1.A of the Idaho Model Ordinance.**

Watch for parts in blue that say “***Excludes Regs (___)”. If your Level of Reg is listed here, for example it includes “Regs (d)”, then you can chose the “n/a” box and a code reference isn’t required because the language isn’t required.
