On May 1, 2012, the Idaho Department of Water Resources ("IDWR") issued a *Preliminary Order Creating Water District No.* 2 ("Preliminary Order") in a portion of IDWR's Administrative Basin No. 2 from Milner Dam to the Murphy Gage below Swan Falls Dam.

On July 10, 2012, the Director of IDWR signed a *Final Order Creating Water District No. 2* ("Final Order").

A primary purpose of a water district is the administration of water rights within the water district by a watermaster. A watermaster administers water rights in part by measuring diversions and adjusting controlling works to deliver the authorized flow rates and/or volumes of water to the holders of water rights in the district.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Paragraph four of the Preliminary Order creating Water District No. 2 stated the following:

The Director shall issue a separate order requiring the installation of measuring devices and controlling works for water right diversions within Water District No. 2. The measuring device order shall be issued after the annual water district meeting ... in order to provide some time for the water district advisory committee and other water users to work with IDWR toward developing a reasonable water measurement implementation plan.

- 2. The first annual meeting of the water users of Water District No. 2 was held on January 15, 2013. At the annual meeting, the water users elected a watermaster and selected an advisory committee in accordance with Idaho Code § 42-605.
- 3. The advisory committee of Water District No. 2 has met twice since the 2013 annual water users meeting. IDWR representatives have met with the advisory committee and the watermaster to discuss the issuance and implementation of a measuring device order for diversions in the water district.
- 4. Representatives from IDWR and the Idaho Water Resources Board worked with interested water district water users in December, 2012 and January, 2013 on a United States Bureau of Reclamation ("USBR") WaterSmart grant application for cost sharing of measuring

devices in the water district. Due to limited resources and a narrow time frame for submittal of the grant application, the grant was submitted for only 22 diversions in the water district. The USBR approved the cost share grant for all 22 diversions in May, 2013.

- 5. At the advisory committee meeting on July 10, 2013, the advisory committee recommended a phased approach to compliance with IDWR measurement orders. Specifically, the committee recommended that diversions benefitting from the USBR cost share grant awarded in 2013 be in compliance with measurement requirements by the 2014 irrigation season and those diversions serving more than one thousand (1,000) acres should be in compliance with IDWR measurement requirements by the 2015 irrigation season. The committee further recommended that all remaining diversions in the water district be in compliance with IDWR measurement requirements by December 31, 2016, except that water right diversions used for irrigation of 5 acres or less and/or for non-irrigation uses in which the total authorized rate of diversion is 0.24 cubic feet per second (cfs) or less should not be subject to measuring device requirements.
- 6. IDWR water rights records and field inventory of diversions indicate that there are five (5) diversions in Water District No. 2, in addition to several diversions included in the BOR WaterSmart Grant, where each diversion serves between 500 and 1,000 irrigated acres. IDWR finds that it is prudent to adjust the recommendation of the advisory committee so that diversions serving more than 500 acres of irrigation are in compliance with IDWR measurement requirements by the 2015 irrigation season. IDWR further finds that it is reasonable for all remaining diversions in the district to come into compliance with IDWR measurement requirements by the start of the 2016 irrigation season.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 1. Idaho Code § 42-701 provides in pertinent part:
- 42-701 INSTALLATION AND MAINTENANCE OF CONTROLLING WORKS AND MEASURING DEVICES BY WATER APPROPRIATORS PROCEDURE UPON FAILURE TO INSTALL AND MAINTAIN MEASURING AND REPORTING OF DIVERSIONS PENALTY FOR FAILURE TO COMPLY REPORT FILING FEE.
- (1) The appropriators or users of any public waters of the state of Idaho shall maintain to the satisfaction of the director of the department of water resources suitable headgates and controlling works at the point where the water is diverted. Each device shall be of such construction that it can be locked and kept closed by the watermaster or other officer in charge, and shall also be of such construction as to regulate the flow of water at the diversion point. Each such appropriator shall construct and maintain, when required by the director of the department of water resources, a rating flume or other measuring device at such point as is most practical in such canal, ditch, wellhead or pipeline for the purpose of assisting the watermaster or department in determining the amount of water that may be diverted into said canal, ditch, wellhead or pipeline from the stream, well or other source of public water. Plans for such headgates, rating flumes or other measuring devices shall be approved by the department of water resources.

- (2) If an appropriator determines that installation and maintenance of a measuring device required by the director would be burdensome for his diversion, the appropriator may, upon approval of the director, execute an agreement with the director and submit to the director such information and technical data concerning the diversion and pumping facilities as the director determines necessary to establish the relationship of power usage to water withdrawal by any pump used to divert public water.
- (3) Any appropriator or user of the public waters of the state of Idaho that neglects or refuses to construct or maintain such headgates, controlling works, or measuring devices..., upon receiving ten (10) days' notice from the director of the department of water resources within which to begin and diligently pursue to completion the construction or installation of the required device or devices or to begin and diligently pursue to completion a remedy to such defects as exist in accordance with said notice, then the director of the department of water resources may order the duly qualified and acting watermaster of the water district to shut off and refuse to deliver at the point of diversion, the water owned by such appropriator or user until the user does construct and maintain such headgates, controlling works or measuring devices or remedy the defects which exist or the director may take action pursuant to section 42-1701B, Idaho Code, to enforce the requirement to construct, install or maintain such devices.
- (4) The appropriators or users of the public waters of the state of Idaho shall be given a reasonable time within which to complete construction of such headgates, controlling works or measuring devices, depending upon the size and extent thereof, when due diligence has been used in the prosecution of such work.
- 2. Measurement of diversions is necessary in Water District No. 2 for the proper distribution of water and administration of water rights. Measurement of diversions provides the following administrative benefits:
 - i. Assurance that water rights are used within their authorized diversion limits and provide ability to regulate rights to authorized diversion limits if such limits are exceeded. Monitoring and regulation of water right diversions rates and limits apply to those rights and diversions subject to Water Supply Bank (WSB) leases and rentals. WSB leases and rentals result in temporary changes to water right points of diversions, rates of diversion and places of uses. There are many active WSB leases and rentals within Water District No. 2.
 - ii. Certainty that junior priority water rights diverted from the Snake River within the water district or diverted from tributary sources outside of the water district are not unnecessarily curtailed to protect more senior priority rights in the district, including the State's minimum stream flow water rights at the Murphy Gage Station located below Swan Falls Dam.
 - iii. An equitable, defensible and legal means for determining water user assessments since Idaho law requires that the expenses of the water district be based on water delivery.
- 3. The Director should require the installation of measuring devices for diversions of water from the Snake River within Water District No. 2.

ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. The holders of water rights in Water District No. 2, except those water rights listed in subsection a. below, shall install on each point of diversion from the Snake River a measuring device of a type acceptable to IDWR for the purpose of assisting the water district watermaster in measuring and reporting the amount of water withdrawn from each diversion. Water rights that are exempt from the measuring device requirements of this order are limited to:
 - a. Any water right(s) in which the point of diversion is used for irrigation of five (5) acres or less and/or a non-irrigation use in which the total rate of diversion is 0.24 cfs or less.
- 2. Prior to the diversion of water for the 2014 irrigation season, acceptable measuring devices shall be installed for those diversions and water rights benefitting from the 2013 USBR WaterSmart grant. The water rights benefiting from the grant are identified in Attachment A of this order. Measurement plans have already been developed for the diversions listed in Attachment A.
- 3. Prior to the diversion of water for the 2015 irrigation season, acceptable measuring devices shall be installed for those diversions in which the total authorized water rights irrigated acreage is five hundred (500) acres or more. A list of water rights identified by IDWR as meeting this condition is provided in Attachment B for informational purposes. The watermaster will work with the holders of water rights meeting this condition to develop measurement plans for each point of diversion by March 1, 2014.
- 4. All remaining diversions and water rights not otherwise exempt from this order shall have acceptable measuring devices installed by the start of the 2016 irrigation season. Owners of all remaining diversions and water rights in Water District No. 2 and not listed in either Attachments A and B, and not exempt from this order shall submit a measurement plan for each point of diversion to the water district watermaster by March 1, 2015. The measurement plan shall be reviewed by the watermaster to determine whether proposed measuring devices are of a type acceptable to IDWR, and that the device(s) will be installed according to specifications.
- 5. Measuring devices that are acceptable to IDWR are listed in IDWR's *Minimum Acceptable Standards for Open Channel and Closed Conduit Measuring Devices* (copy attached). These specifications apply to both irrigation and non-irrigation water uses.
- 6. Under limited circumstances, a variance of the standard measuring devices listed in IDWR's *Minimum Acceptable Standards for Open Channel and Closed Conduit Measuring Devices* may be considered upon submittal of a written justification and plan to the watermaster. Acceptable variances may include the following methods or devices:
 - Development of a Power Consumption Coefficient (PCC), which is a ratio of power usage to water withdrawal. Acceptance of the PCC method may be provided *for qualifying irrigation diversions only*;
 - Use of an hour meter (time clock) for qualifying diversions only;
 - For closed conduit diversions, use of an acceptable non-standard flow meter that was installed *prior to the date of this order*;

• For irrigation diversions only, use of an acceptable non-standard flow meter where it can be shown that installation of a standard flow meter would be burdensome.

Requests for variance of the measurement method must be received no later than the applicable Plan Due Date shown in items 3 or 4 of this section, and will be considered by the water district watermaster and the IDWR on a case-by-case basis. Variances proposing use of an existing flow meter must meet IDWR criteria and accuracy tests. Existing meters which do not meet standards, or which fail, will be required to be replaced with a magnetic flow meter unless another variance is obtained. The suitability of any pumping plant for approval of an hour meter or the PCC method of measurement will be based on criteria found in the *IDWR ESPA Water Measurement and Reporting Guidelines* (copy available upon request or online at

http://www.idwr.idaho.gov/WaterManagement/WaterMeasurement/water_measurement.htm.) The Department may provide guidance to the water district watermaster with respect to variance requests and approvals.

- 7. In some situations, IDWR may exempt a diversion from the requirements of this order or may allow deferred compliance for a diversion. IDWR will consider each request for exemption or deferral on a case-by-case basis. Conditions that may result in exemption or deferral include, but are not limited to, the following:
 - Abandonment, non-use, or consolidation of diversions that results in a diversion being unused, or reduces the total diversion rate to 0.24 cfs or less and/or irrigation of five acres or less.
 - Delays caused by requirements of other government entities.
- 8. This Order shall be effective immediately on any new diversion(s) authorized after the date of this Order, except water right diversions used for irrigation of 5 acres or less and/or for non-irrigation uses in which the total authorized rate of diversion is 0.24 cfs or less.
- 9. This Order does not require the installation of lockable controlling works, although nothing in this Order shall preclude the watermaster from mandating the installation of lockable controlling works on any diversion if such works are determined to be necessary for adequate administration and control of the diversion.
- 10. The watermaster shall shut off and refuse to deliver water to any diversion that does not have, or who fails to maintain, an adequate measuring device at any and all times following the required installation dates established in this order unless an exemption or deferral has been provided by IDWR.

EXPLANATORY INFORMATION TO ACCOMPANY A FINAL ORDER

(To be used in connection with actions when a hearing was not held)

(Required by Rule of Procedure 740.02)

The accompanying order is a "Final Order" issued by the department pursuant to section 67-5246, Idaho Code.

PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION

Any party may file a petition for reconsideration of a final order within fourteen (14) days of the service date of this order as shown on the certificate of service. **Note: The petition must** be <u>received</u> by the Department within this fourteen (14) day period. The department will act on a petition for reconsideration within twenty-one (21) days of its receipt, or the petition will be considered denied by operation of law. See section 67-5246(4), Idaho Code.

REQUEST FOR HEARING

Unless the right to a hearing before the director or the water resource board is otherwise provided by statute, any person who is aggrieved by the action of the director, and who has not previously been afforded an opportunity for a hearing on the matter shall be entitled to a hearing before the director to contest the action. The person shall file with the director, within fifteen (15) days after receipt of written notice of the action issued by the director, or receipt of actual notice, a written petition stating the grounds for contesting the action by the director and requesting a hearing. See section 42-1701A(3), Idaho Code. **Note: The request must be** received by the Department within this fifteen (15) day period.

APPEAL OF FINAL ORDER TO DISTRICT COURT

Pursuant to sections 67-5270 and 67-5272, Idaho Code, any party aggrieved by a final order or orders previously issued in a matter before the department may appeal the final order and all previously issued orders in the matter to district court by filing a petition in the district court of the county in which:

- i. A hearing was held,
- ii. The final agency action was taken,
- iii. The party seeking review of the order resides, or
- iv. The real property or personal property that was the subject of the agency action is located.

The appeal must be filed within twenty-eight (28) days of: a) the service date of the final order, b) the service date of an order denying petition for reconsideration, or c) the failure within twenty-one (21) days to grant or deny a petition for reconsideration, whichever is later. See section 67-5273, Idaho Code. The filing of an appeal to district court does not in itself stay the effectiveness or enforcement of the order under appeal.
