Craig,

I know it's been awhile since you worked on these, but I am reviewing the protests and the withdrawal of protests for the IWRB's recharge permits.

For most Protestants, I am seeing a clear path: protest->continued interest-> withdrawal of protest.

However, Fred F Kippes and Betty J Kippes filed a protest on 2-7474 (which became 1-7143 and one of the predecessors to 1-10609) but they fell off the radar for the redo. They did not get listed as a party in your April 19, 2013 letter to the Protestants. Do you remember contacting them separately?

I looked through all the documents I have in connection with the IWRB recharge permits and do not see specific documentation stating that Fred and Betty Kippes shared with me their intent to renew, or not to renew, their protest originally filed for 2-7474.

However, I seemed to recall speaking with the Kippes so I looked through my old call logs and found that I spoke with Betty Kippes on 2-26-13. My call log notes specifically say:

"2-26-13 - Betty Kippes. Question about re-protesting IWRB ground water recharge applications"

My memory of the conversation was that she wasn't sure if she was going to renew her protest if there were others already protesting.

None-the-less, this would indicate that Mrs. Kippes received the February 23, 2013, letter mailed to the parties that had previously filed a protest, and she was calling with questions about that letter.
