Subject: Application for Amendment of Permit No. 63-32225 for Intermountain Sewer & Water Corporation

Dear Angie,

In response to your October 27, 2009 request letter for additional information regarding the above-referenced application, the following is provided:

Place of Use. An amended and initialed page one of amended application 63-32225 is enclosed to include land in the NESW Section 33, T1N R4E. This land was identified on the associated map but not in the application place of use description.

Property Ownership. The additional place of use proposed on the amended application is located in Elmore County and includes the following parcels:

- RP01N04E341210A Greg & Heidi Johnson
- RP01N04E353010A Arbor Ridge, LLC
- RP01N04E340040 Arbor Ridge, LLC

Greg Johnson is President of Intermountain Sewer & Water Corporation and managing member for Greg and Heidi Johnson and Arbor Ridge, LLC. This relationship between the applicant and the above property owners establishes the applicant's possessory interest in the additional property proposed in the amended place of use.

Diversion System. Water right 63-32225 was filed for diversion of ground water in Ada County, Basin 63. Application 63-32973 (needs re-numbered to basin 61) was filed for diversion of ground water in Elmore County, Basin 61. The proposed wells in both counties will be part of an integrated ground water system that will provide municipal water to Mayfield Springs Planned Community.

Approval Status. Applicants submitted their Planned Community Application to Elmore County in Spring, 2009 and anticipate an acceptance letter by December 15, 2009. Public hearings are expected to last until June, 2010. Final County approval is expected by June 30, 2010.

PWS permitting has been initiated with DEQ and will continue through 2010. So far, three project well sites and plans have been approved by DEQ. First phase engineering will begin May, 2010. Construction of wells and the project water system is scheduled to start in Fall, 2010.

Application for Permit 63-32973. Also enclosed is an amended page two of associated application for permit 63-32973 filed for the proposed wells in Elmore County. The place of use listed for this application also excludes the NESW Section 33 tract. Please attach this amended page to that application so that the NESW Section 33 tract is included.
