WHEREAS, On the 2nd day of February, A. D. 1910, MARY WIEBELHOUSE, of Mayfield, County of Elmore, State of Idaho, duly made application (No. 8265) to me for a permit to use four (4) cubic feet per second of the waters of Slater and North Slater creeks, County of Elmore, State of Idaho, for irrigation and domestic purposes, and

WHEREAS, On the 2nd day of February, A. D. 1910, Permit No. 5725 was issued to said applicant for the diversion of said water, and providing for the completion of the works of diversion therein described on or before the 2nd day of February, A. D. 1912, and for the application to beneficial use of said water on or before the 2nd day of February A. D. 1913, and,

WHEREAS, On the 25th day of July, A. D. 1910, MARY WIEBELHOUSE, the holder of said permit duly made proof of the completion of adequate works for the diversion of four (4) cubic feet per second of said waters, as evidenced by my Certificate No. 5725, dated July 20, 1911, confirming the completion of works of sufficient capacity for diverting and conveying to the place of intended use four (4) cubic feet per second of said waters, with date of priority of February 2, 1910, and

WHEREAS, On the 25th day of July, A. D. 1910, MARY WIEBELHOUSE, the holder of said permit duly made proof of the application to beneficial use of 2.1 cubic feet per second of said water:

NOW, THEREFORE, By virtue of authority vested in me by the laws of the State of Idaho, I hereby grant and confirm to MARY WIEBELHOUSE, of Mayfield, County of Elmore, State of Idaho, the holder and owner of said Permit No. 5725, a perpetual right, dating from February 2, 1910, to the use of two and one-tenth (2.1) cubic feet per second of the waters of SLATER AND NORTH SLATER CREEKS, in the County of Elmore, and State of Idaho, or so much thereof as may be necessary for the purposes hereinbelow mentioned, to be diverted from Slater creek at a point in the SW4 of NE4 Section 12, and from North Slater creek at a point in the SE4 of NW4 and a point in NE4 SW4, Section 12, Township 1 North, Range 4 East of Boise, Meridian, and conducted to and upon 105 acres as follows: (15 acres in SE4 of NW4; 30 acres in SW4 of NE4, 30 acres in NE4 of SW4; 5 acres in NW4 of SE4; 25 acres in SE4 of SW4, All in Section 12, Township 1 North, Range 4 East of Boise Meridian, for the purpose of irrigation and domestic use, subject, however, to the laws of the State of Idaho applicable to a license for the use of the waters of the State, and subject, also, to the local or community customs, rules and regulations which have been or may be adopted from time to time by a majority of the users from a common source of supply, canal or lateral from which such water may be taken, when such rules and regulations have for their object the economical use of such water.

## APPLICATION FOR PERMIT

To Appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Idaho

1. Name of applicant: Mary Wiebelhouse

2. The quantity of water claimed is 2 cubic feet per second from diversion No. 1, on North Slater Creek and 1 cubic foot per second from diversion No. 2, and equivalent to a continuous flow of 1 cubic foot per second from Slater Creek, Diversion No. 3.

3. Source of water supply: North Slater Creek and Slater Creek

County of Elmore

4. Location of points of diversion: No. 3, on Slater Creek in SW $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$  Sec. 12, 1 N. 4 E. B.M. on North Slater Creek No. 1, SE $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$  Said Sec. 12; On North Slater Creek No. 2, in NE $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$  said Sec. 12, T. 1 N. R. 4 E. B.M.

5. To be used for:

I. Irrigation and domestic use:

(a) Amount of land to be irrigated: 200 acres.

(b) In the following legal subdivisions: SE $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$ , SW $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$ , NW $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$ , E $\frac{1}{2}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$  Sec. 12, T. 1 N. R. 4 E. B.M.

6. Estimated cost of works: \$200.00

7. Description of works for diversion:

I. Kind of works: Three small ditches from points of diversion to land to be irrigated

II. Dimensions of works:

(d) Conduit ditches, width at bottom 1 foot, width at water line 1 $\frac{1}{2}$  feet, depth of water  $\frac{1}{2}$  foot. Average grade per mile is 6 feet. Length of conduits are in all about 1 $\frac{1}{2}$  miles, and it crosses the following quarter sections: NE $\frac{1}{4}$ , NW $\frac{1}{4}$ , SE $\frac{1}{4}$ , SW $\frac{1}{4}$  Sec. 12, T. 1 N. R. 4 E., to land described in 5 I (b) above which is the point of intended use.

8. The time required for the completion of the construction of such work is 2 years.

9. Time required for the complete application of the water to the proposed use is 1 additional year.

BE IT KNOWN, That the undersigned hereby makes application for a permit to appropriate the public waters of the State of Idaho as herein set forth.

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


