I. PROCEDURAL BACKGROUND

On January 17, 2006, the Director of the Idaho Department of Water Resources ("IDWR") filed a *Director's Report for Irrigation & Other Uses, Reporting Area Basin 21*, which included a recommendation for General Provisions in Basin 21. The recommended General Provisions are attached as Exhibit 1.


A review of the SRBA Court files reveals that no *Objections* were specifically filed to the general provision portion of the Basin 21 *Director's Report*.

This Special Master finds that the connected sources general provision recommended in the Basin 21 *Director's Report* is consistent with the *Memorandum Decision and Order of Partial Decree* in Basin Wide Issue No. 5. (subcase 91-00005)(Feb. 27, 2002).

II. CONCLUSIONS

Therefore, all *Objections* in Basin 21 relating to the General Provisions have been resolved. There are no outstanding *Objections* to the *Director's Recommendation*. Therefore, IT IS RECOMMENDED that the Basin 21 General Provisions be decreed as recommended in the *Director's Report* and as set forth in the attached Exhibit 2.


