# NOTICE OF FILING FOR REPORTING AREA 6 (IDWR BASIN 55):

- ▶ **Conjunctive Management Director's Report**
- ▶ **Irrigation Season Of Use Supplemental Report**

The Director of the Idaho Department of Water Resources (IDWR) has filed with the Snake River Basin Adjudication (SRBA) District Court his Report for Basin 55 regarding the interconnection of water resources within the Snake River Basin. This Report is the Director's recommendation for the conjunctive management general provision that should be decreed for Basin 55.

Additionally, the Director of IDWR has filed with the SRBA District Court a supplemental report changing his recommendation for the irrigation season of use for the following water rights:

The Court will decide how it will decree a conjunctive management provision in Basin 55 and the irrigation season of use. You are free to agree or disagree with the Director's recommendations in these reports. If you agree with the Director's recommendation you do not need to do anything, pending further notice as described below. If you disagree with the Director's recommendation, you need to file an objection as described below.

## INSTRUCTIONS FOR REVIEWING THESE REPORTS

Attached to this Notice is the complete Conjunctive Management Director's Report for Basin 55. The complete Irrigation Season of Use Supplemental Report for Basin 55 is available at the SRBA courthouse in Twin Falls and the locations listed on the third page of this notice. Copies of the report can be made, but you may be charged for copying and mailing. If you are claiming a right for which the Director has issued a new irrigation season of use recommendation, a complete description of the Director's recommendation for your claim is attached to this Notice. If so, you need to carefully review the new season of use recommended for your irrigation right.

## INSTRUCTIONS FOR TAKING AN ISSUE TO COURT

### *What do I do if I disagree with the conjunctive management provision or a season of use recommendation?*

If you disagree with IDWR's conjunctive management provision, or the season of use recommendation for your water right or anyone else's water right, and want to be heard in court, file an objection with the SRBA Court. Objections must be made on the standard objection form available from any IDWR office or from the SRBA Court and copies mailed to the parties shown on that form. You may also download a copy of the objection form from the SRBA Web Site at [www.srba.state.id.us](http://www.srba.state.id.us) or the IDWR Web Site at [www.idwr.state.id.us/idwr/info/water/srba/main.htm](http://www.idwr.state.id.us/idwr/info/water/srba/main.htm).

Your objection to IDWR's conjunctive management provision, or the irrigation season of use for the rights listed above must be **received** by the SRBA Court on or before **January 29, 1999**.

### *What do I do if someone else objects to with the conjunctive management provision or a season of use recommendation?*

If someone files an objection to IDWR's conjunctive management provision, or the season of use recommendation for your water right or anyone else's water right, you may file a response to that objection. Responses to objections must be made on the standard response form available from any IDWR office or from the SRBA Court. Your response must be **received** by the SRBA Court on or before **March 5, 1999**.

### *What happens if there are no objections to a water right?*

After the deadline for filing objections, the SRBA Court will hear the uncontested recommendations on **March 9, 1999**, at **10:30 A.M.** at the **SRBA Courthouse**. Any part of the report to which no objections are filed may be decreed by the district court.

### *How will I know about the proceedings on water right recommendations to which objections were filed?*

A notice will be mailed to you for court dates on your water right or for those where you filed an objection or a response. You will not receive notice of court dates on any other water right recommendations. Additional information regarding the SRBA can be found on the SRBA Web Site at [www.srba.state.id.us](http://www.srba.state.id.us).

*Note:* The SRBA Court publishes a monthly Docket Sheet listing all objections and responses filed. It does not list court dates for individual water right cases, but provides general information helpful to all participants in the SRBA. The Docket Sheet is available at your county courthouse and all IDWR offices, or you may subscribe by contacting the SRBA Court or IDWR. The annual subscription fee is \$7.50. The Docket Sheet is also available on the SRBA Web Site at [www.srba.state.id.us](http://www.srba.state.id.us).



On November 24, 1998, pursuant to Idaho Code § 42-1411(3), the Director of the Idaho Department of Water Resources filed a *Director's Report* recommending general provisions applicable to water rights in Basin 55. The only general provision recommended by the Director in Basin 55 is the connected sources (conjunctive management) general provision. No objections have been filed to the general provision portion of the Basin 55 *Director's Report*. On March 9, 1999, pursuant to Idaho Code § 42-1412(7), the Court held a hearing on those portions of the *Director's Report* for which no objection was filed.

On February 27, 2002, Judge Burdick issued a *Memorandum Decision and Order of Partial Decree* in Basin Wide Issue 5 (Connected Sources General Provision), subcase 91-00005. Therein, Judge Burdick decreed the form of the conjunctive management general provision to be used in each administrative basin within the Snake River Basin Adjudication. The connected sources general provision recommended in the Basin 55 *Director's Report* has been modified to make it consistent with the *Order* issued in Basin Wide Issue 5.

In accordance with the foregoing, IT IS ORDERED that the Basin 55 general provisions are hereby **decreed** as set forth in the *Partial Decree Pursuant to I.R.C.P. 54(b)* entered contemporaneously herewith.




