
On September 30, 2002, December 16, 2005, and December 19, 2006, pursuant to Idaho Code § 42-1411(3), the Director of the Idaho Department of Water Resources filed *Director's Reports* recommending general provisions applicable to water rights in Basin 63. The only general provision recommended by the Director in Basin 63 is the connected sources (conjunctive management) general provision.

A review of the Court's files and records reveals that no objections have been specifically filed to the general provision portion of the Basin 63 *Director's Reports*. Additionally, upon a review of the subcases with unresolved objections in Basin 63, this Special Master finds that none of those subcases involve issues that relate to the recommended Basin 63 general provisions..

On February 27, 2002, Judge Burdick issued a *Memorandum Decision and Order of Partial Decree* in Basin Wide Issue 5 (Connected Sources General Provision), subcase 91-00005. Therein, Judge Burdick decreed the form of the conjunctive management general provision to be used in each administrative basin within the Snake River Basin Adjudication. This Special Master finds that connected sources general provision recommended in the Basin 63 *Director's Reports* is consistent with the *Order* issued in Basin Wide Issue 5.

In accordance with the foregoing, IT IS RECOMMENDED that the Basin 63 general provisions be **decreed** as set forth in the attached *Recommendation for Partial Decree Pursuant to I.R.C.P. 54(b) for General Provisions in Basin 63*.


