Candice,

No, my intent was not to suggest that some files may have been destroyed. Some water rights just have never had a water right back file. It is my understanding that the purpose of your request was to make sure that the electronic "back file" of scanned documents available online for the water rights matched the records in IDWR's records vault. I was using the term paper to distinguish between the vault files and what is on line, but I should have been more precise. The Department has reviewed the records in the vault (including micro-fiche) for the water rights listed and they match what is on line. Hope this helps clarify. Let me know if you have any more questions.
