Dear Water Users in Water District 36A:

This letter is notice that on May 29, 2014, the Idaho Ground Water Appropriators, Inc. ("IGWA"), filed with the Department *IGWA's Amended Third Mitigation Plan and Request for Hearing* ("Third Mitigation Plan"). IGWA's Third Mitigation Plan seeks to mitigate the material injury to Water Right Nos. 36-02551 & 36-07694 held by Rangen, Inc. IGWA's Third Mitigation Plan also seeks to mitigate any material injury caused by ground water pumping to other surface water rights within Water District 36A for which a delivery call has been filed or for which a delivery call may be filed in the future. I sent you this letter because Department records identify you as the holder of a surface water right within Water District 36A.

The Department published legal notice of the Third Mitigation Plan in newspapers circulated within the affected counties. Enclosed with this mailing is a copy of the notice. The notice generally describes the proposal. The deadline for filing a protest to the approval of the plan is July 7, 2014. Please note that there is a protest filing fee of \$25.00 that is due at the time of filing in order for the protest to be valid.
