

Plaintiffs before the Defendants' attorney can be heard in opposition because the Defendants have threatened to issue a Curtailment Order on May 14, 2007, before any hearing can be conducted by the Court on Plaintiff's Application for a Preliminary Injunction, and Plaintiff's attorney certifies to the Court in writing the efforts made to give notice and the reasons the Plaintiff claims that notice should not be required.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Defendants be and are hereby temporarily restrained and enjoined from issuing a Curtailment Order or curtailing Plaintiffs from pumping ground water in accordance with their respective water rights to prevent immediate and irreparable harm or injury and to maintain the status quo pending a hearing on Plaintiffs' Application for a Preliminary Injunction.

This Temporary Restraining Order granted without notice is issued May 8, 2007, at the hour of 9:00 a.m. shall be filed forthwith in the Clerk's Office and entered of record and served upon the Defendants and their attorneys; and shall expire by its terms on the date of the Show Cause Hearing on Plaintiff's Application for Preliminary Injunction, unless extended by the Court.
