

TO: THE DISTRICT COURT AND PARTIES OF RECORD

YOU ARE HEREBY NOTIFIED pursuant to Rule 84(j) of the Idaho Rules of Civil Procedure (“I.R.C.P.”) that the agency record and transcript, having been prepared pursuant to I.R.C.P. 84(f) and (g), are lodged with the agency for the purpose of settlement in accordance with I.R.C.P. 84(j).

A CD containing the contents of the record and transcript is now available to the Petitioner at the agency’s office. However, counsel for Petitioner and the agency have agreed the agency will deliver the CD to counsel for Petitioner tomorrow at counsel’s office. Pursuant to Rule 84(g)(1)(A), the Petitioner has paid \$650.00 per the estimated fee for the preparation of the transcript. Petitioner has also paid an additional \$3.25, the estimated cost for preparation of the record. The actual preparation cost of the transcript is \$390.00. The actual preparation cost of the record is \$91.00. The agency does not anticipate any further charges affiliated with the continued preparation of the record. However, the agency will inform Petitioner immediately should additional charges be incurred. After the transcript and record are settled and lodged with the district court, the agency will refund the balance to Petitioner.

The parties have fourteen (14) days from the date of the mailing of this notice in which to file any objections to the transcript and record. If no objections are filed within that time, the record and transcript shall be deemed settled. The agency’s decision on any objection timely filed along with all evidence, exhibits and written presentation of the objection shall be included in the record. Thereafter, the agency shall lodge the settled transcript and record with the district court pursuant to I.R.C.P. 84(k).
