As you are aware, Gordon Sylte was re appointed as a Flood Control Commissioner /Chairman on Dec 6 2018. He is also a party to a legal matter in which he is petitioning for preferential treatment for water rights associated with the Twin Lakes, Idaho flood control district.

Due to the pending litigation, Mr. Sytle is clearly not independent with regard to water rights and water administration for the flood control district. His candidacy should never have been validated if properly vetted. The conflict from a lengthy pending court case and his position on the flood control is obvious.

Absent a prudent decision to reassign the role of Flood Control Commissioner/Chairman to another candidate who is not conflicted, the Idaho Department of Water Resources is opening itself to criticism and adverse publicity. I strongly encourage the IDWR's decision to retract that appointment and assign it to an individual who is not a party to ongoing litigation with regard to the Twin Lakes, Idaho flood control district.
