STATEMENT OF CONCERN**


Trout Unlimited ("TU"), by and through counsel, hereby submits its Statement of Concern pursuant to the *Notice of Contested Case and Formal Proceedings, and Notice of Status Conference* entered in this matter on October 22, 2013.

TU is a non-profit membership organization dedicated to conserving, protecting and restoring North America's coldwater fisheries and their watersheds. TU has approximately 155,000 members nationally and approximately 2,100 members in the State of Idaho. TU, as an organization and on behalf of its members, is concerned with and seeks to protect and maintain the coldwater fishery in the Boise River. TU and its staff and members enjoy the Boise River for fishing, ecological, aesthetic, business and other purposes throughout the year. TU's concern is that the Idaho Department of Water Resource's decision in this proceeding could change the in-stream storage accounting system in a way that harms these fishing, ecological, aesthetic, business, and other purposes, which depend upon adequate stream flows in the Boise River and are directly affected by in-stream storage.

TU will be unable to attend the pre-hearing conference scheduled in this matter due to a pre-existing obligation. TU's general position is that any activity in this proceeding

should be stayed until the Idaho Supreme Court's decision regarding SRBA Basin-Wide issue 17.
