Water Experts to Assess the Water Supply at February Meeting

Come to the Water Supply Committee meeting and find out about the current snow pack and the water supply outlook. Water managers and hydrology experts will meet in Boise on Friday, February 14, 2014.

The Idaho Water Supply Committee meeting will cover topics that include drought, weather, climate, reservoir operation, river flows, and snowpack. The committee includes water managers and hydrology experts from state and federal agencies and the private sector.

The meeting is open to the public and will take place at the Idaho Department of Water Resources headquarters at the Idaho Water Center in downtown Boise. Members of the committee will make presentations and review the latest data with other agencies and the public and assess the outlook for water supplies for the upcoming season along with the possibility of flooding.
