Experts to discuss statewide water supply Friday, February 9

BOISE – (February 2, 2018) - Find out the latest snowpack, river flow and water supply information for the state of Idaho at the next Idaho Water Supply Committee meeting on Friday, February 9, at the Idaho Department of Water Resources office in Boise.

The meeting is open to the public. Water, snowpack and flood-control experts from state and federal agencies and the private sector will be on hand to give presentations and answer questions.

The Idaho Water Supply meeting will cover all of the relevant information regarding weather forecasts, snowpack, river flow forecasts, reservoir operations, and the potential for flooding. Snowpack levels in Idaho range from a low of 39 percent of normal in the Owyhee basin to a high of 112 percent of normal in the Snake River above Palisades basin.

Public parking is located in the Idaho Water Center underground parking garage. Please note that there is a parking fee to park in the garage. However, the first hour of parking is free.
