Welcome and Introductions

Helen Harrington began the meeting with introductions and explanation of the objectives of the meeting.

Public Comment Period

Lynn Tominaga discussed the ground water districts and other districts. The Advisory Committee members asked questions about how the district compared with other designations in the Rathdrum Prairie area.

Status of Recommended RP CAMP

Helen Harrington discussed the status and anticipated actions the IWRB will take in response to the submission of the final recommended Plan. The Plan was submitted at the January 2011 IWRB meeting. The IWRB will consider the Plan at the March 12 IWRB meeting. If the IWRB accepts the Plan for consideration, public hearing and a 60-day comment period will be scheduled. After the March meeting, Helen will inform the Committee of the IWRB decision.

Brainstorm Implementation Projects and Costs

AC members held a discussion about actions, issues and concerns related to the implementation of the recommended RP CAMP. Staff will work with the ideas generated from that discussion and circulate a draft list of projects. Staff will also begin estimating costs associated with the proposed projects.
