IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the respective parties and decreed hereto be, and each of them is hereby awarded/the quantity of water hereinafter specified with date of priority; and for the irrigation of lands as herein-before set forth, such water to be directed from the several points of diversion as herein after stated, all rights herein decreed to be either what is hereinafter designated as "Meadow Right" or an "Agricultural Right" and to be by the respective dates and particular years fixed as the date of priority:
