as enlarged and the depth of each well. This water right is based upon water savings from constructing, maintaining  
and operating the Baseline Bypass Canal ("Canal") to circumvent a losing reach of the Big Wood River downstream  
from Bellevue. During the irrigation season, when the Canal can carry the entire flow of the river (up to about 200  
cfs), Big Wood River water rights diverting in and downstream of the by-passed losing reach, then in priority without  
the savings afforded by operating the Canal, are delivered through the Canal. The court has determined that a flow  
rate of 18 cfs is saved whenever the Canal is operating. The shareholders of Upper Wood River Water Users  
Association, Inc. ("UWRWUA") take their portions of the 11.232 cfs of this saved water decreed to the UWRWUA from  
flows delivered through the Canal or from diversions located upstream of Magic Reservoir in the Big Wood River  
Basin as listed in Remark No. 2.

13. Remarks:

1. The court determined in the matter of "Upper Big Wood River Water Users' Association *et al* v. S. H Chapman, dated August 28, 1922, that the water saved under this right has a priority of September 1, 1920, but the water is the "sole and exclusive property of said plaintiffs as developed waters, regardless of the date of appropriation." Diversion and use of water under this right is not subject to regulation according to priority of rights in Big Wood River and Tributaries.

2. The point of diversion listed on Page 1 is for the Glendale Diversion. The Baseline Bypass Canal diverts to the east side of the river and the Glendale Canal diverts to the west side of the river at this point. Several canals re-divert saved water from the Baseline Bypass Canal and Extension Bypass Canal. Water is accounted as delivered at the point of re-diversion. The following is a list of the legal descriptions for the points of diversion from Big Wood River and tributaries used by shareholders and of the legal descriptions for the points of re-diversion used by the shareholders.

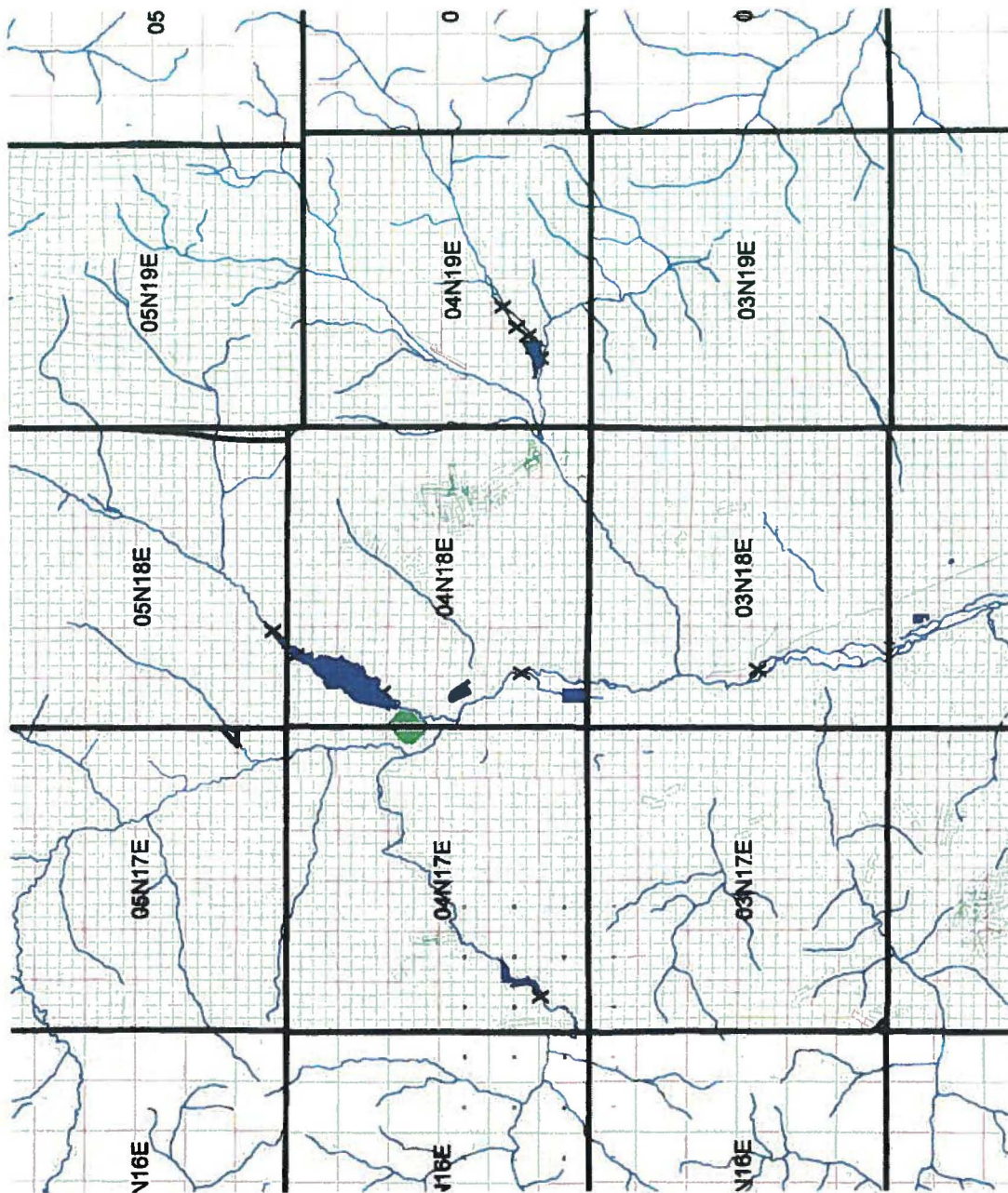

The UWRWUA operates under the provisions of § 42-219(6), Idaho Code, allowing a generally described place of use covering the places of use listed (Ref: Attached affidavit of William L. Sherbine). Primary rights held by the shareholders identifying the places of use are listed in Attachment No."I".

Place of Use

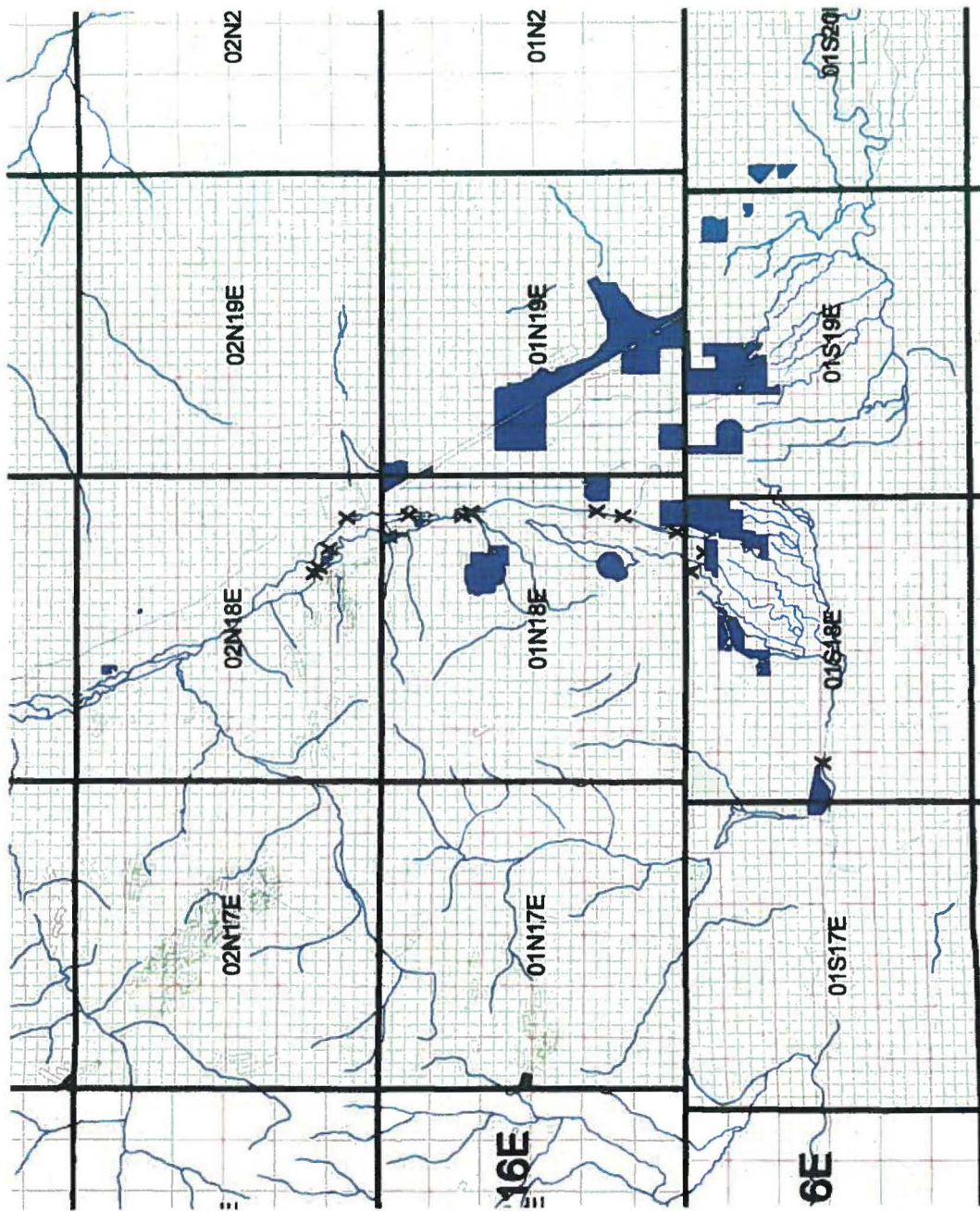
X Point of Diversion
