

WATER RIGHT ADJUDICATION PROPOSAL – BEAR RIVER BASIN

The Idaho Department of Water Resources (IDWR) will be conducting public informational meetings to discuss a proposal to adjudicate the water rights in the Bear River Basin. If commenced, the adjudication will include both surface and ground water rights in those portions of Bannock, Bear Lake, Caribou, Cassia, Franklin, Oneida, and Power Counties within the Bear River Basin. IDWR will present details about a proposed Bear River adjudication at the meeting. IDWR staff will also be available to answer questions and receive input from attendees. All water users are specifically urged to attend.
