If no timely objections are filed with the CFPRBA Court regarding the Director's recommendation for your water right claim(s), your water right(s) are expected to be decreed as recommended within approximately one year. You will receive a decree from the CFPRBA Court. To ensure successful delivery of your decree, please keep the IDWR updated with any changes to your ownership information or mailing address.
