## 2023 SVGWD Hydrology Report

During 2023 the Station 10 discharge remained at 32 cfs or greater during the irrigation season as shown by the attached hydrograph. Also, during 2023 there were no priority cuts on Silver Creek, or the Little Wood River as shown by the attached report from Water District 37.

Also attached is a chart showing the percentage of normal April through September discharge of the Big Wood River at Hailey over the past 20 years. The chart shows the 2021 discharge was the lowest in the past 20 years following the third lowest discharge in the past 20 years that occurred in 2020. The current management plan was developed immediately after the 2020 and 2021 years and should be reviewed considering the longer period of record available for the Hailey gage. Doctor Kaiser's model has added investigation and analysis capability that was not available in 2021 and should be fully utilized as a plan for future years is developed.
