IN THE MATTER OF ALLOCATING WATER MANAGEMENT ACCOUNT FUNDS

RESOLUTION TO ALLOCATE FUNDS FOR NEAR BLACKFOOT TO MINIDOKA REACH GAIN IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS

WHEREAS, the Water Management Account (WMA) was created pursuant to Idaho Code § 42-1760 and is administered by the Idaho Water Resource Board (IWRB) for certain purposes; and

WHEREAS, on July 1, 2024, through Resolution No. 32-2024, the IWRB approved a Fiscal Year 2025 spending plan for appropriations made to the WMA under following legislation:

- House Bill 285, Section 1; passed by the 2019 Idaho Legislature (FY 2020)
- Senate Bill 1121, Section 1; passed by the 2021 Idaho Legislature (FY 2022)
- House Bill 769, Section 6; passed by the 2022 Idaho Legislature (FY 2023)
- House Bill 361, Section 1; passed by the 2023 Idaho Legislature (FY 2024)
- Senate Bill 1411, Section 3; passed by the 2024 Idaho Legislature (FY 2025)

WHEREAS, the WMA Spending Plan considers projects currently identified on the IWRB's Regional Water Sustainability Projects (RWSP) Priority List, Aging Infrastructure Grants, certain IWRB approved loans, and other potential projects and programs; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with direction from the Idaho Governor and Legislature, the IWRB has supported efforts to stop the decline of ground water levels in the Eastern Snake Plain Aquifer (ESPA) through the development of a managed aquifer recharge program and funding other projects intended to reduce ground water use from the ESPA; and

WHEREAS, on August 27, 2024, Idaho Governor Little announced that Idaho would commit \$10 million to improve the long-term health of the ESPA and directed the IWRB to support this effort with funds from the WMA in addition to other existing IWRB funding commitments for ESPA improvement projects; and

WHEREAS, on September 13, 2024, the IWRB reallocated \$10 million of the \$70 million budgeted for the future Dworshak/Clearwater River Pipeline project to ESPA improvement projects; and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the IWRB further allocates \$5 million of the \$10 million reallocated for ESPA improvement projects on September 13, 2024, to projects designed to improve reach gains in the Near Blackfoot-to-Minidoka reach of the Snake River.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the IWRB will develop procedures for accepting and approving project proposals for the use of this \$5 million.
