CAREY VALLEY GROUND WATER DISTRICT PROTEST TO JERRY BINGHAM MITIGATION PLAN

The Carey Valley Ground Water District, by and through counsel McHugh Bromley, PLLC, and pursuant to Rule 43 of the Idaho Department of Water Resources' ("IDWR") *Rules for Conjunctive Management of Surface and Ground Water Resources*, IDAPA 37.03.11 ("CM Rules") and Rule 154 of IDWR's *Rules of Procedure*, IDAPA 37.01.01, hereby files this Protest in the above-captioned mitigation plan filed by Jerry D. Bingham in response to the Surface Water Coalition's delivery call.

BASES FOR PROTEST

1. At various times during the on-going Surface Water Coalition ("SWC") delivery

call, certain junior ground water users have received approval from the Director for CM Rule 43

mitigation plans to allow out-of-priority pumping, including but not limited to the Carey Valley

Ground Water District, who is a party to Final Order Approving Stipulated Mitigation Plan,

Docket No. CM-MP-2024-003 (Jan. 3, 2025).

2. In general terms, the Final Order Approving Stipulated Mitigation Plan requires

CVGWD's members to reduce ground water pumping, engage in recharge activities, and supply

SWC with a volume of storage water in return for the ability to continue to pump ground water

when the Director has predicted material injury.

3. It is understood that Mr. Bingham is within the boundaries of a ground water

district who is party to the Final Order Approving Stipulated Mitigation Plan, yet he has chosen

not to join the district.

4. Because it is unknown how the filing of this separate CM Rule 43 mitigation will

or will not impact the Final Order Approving Stipulated Mitigation Plan and CVGWD's

mitigation obligations arising therefrom, CVGWD files this Protest.

5. CVGWD requests that this Protest be considered continuing in nature and

reserves the right to amend as necessary as additional grounds become apparent during the

course of this proceeding.
