**BIG LOST RIVER GROUND WATER
DISTRICT'S CM RULE 43
MITIGATION PLAN**

The Big Lost River Ground Water District (the “District”), a ground water district organized pursuant to Chapter 52 of Title 42 of the Idaho Code, by and through its above-identified counsel, hereby submits *Big Lost River Ground Water District's CM Rule 43 Mitigation Plan* (this “Plan”) in response to the Surface Water Coalition’s (the “SWC”) ¹ delivery call (hereinafter, the

“SWC Call”). The SWC Call was initially filed in January of 2005 and is ongoing. The SWC Call has resulted in certain administrative orders from the Director of the Idaho Department of Water Resources (“IDWR” or “Department”) which quantifies material injury to the SWC’s senior surface water rights resulting from junior ground water diversions from the Eastern Snake Plain Aquifer (“ESPA”). The most recent iteration of methodology to determine and quantify material injury to each individual member of the SWC is now described in the Director’s *Sixth Amended Final Order Regarding Methodology for Determining Material Injury to Reasonable In-Season Demand and Reasonable Carryover* dated July 19, 2023 (the “Methodology Order”).

The Plan is submitted pursuant to Rule 43 of the Idaho Department of Water Resources’ *Rules for Conjunctive Management of Surface and Ground Water Resources* found at IDAPA² 37.03.11 (hereinafter, the “CM Rules”). Rule 43 of the CM Rules is hereafter referred to as “CM Rule 43.”

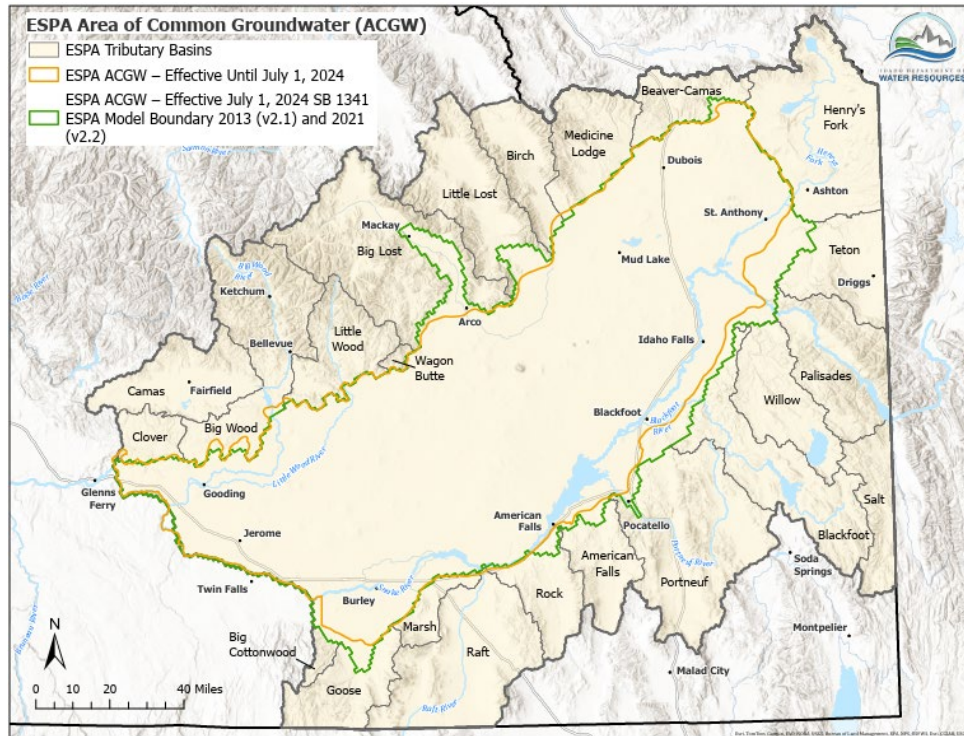
Patrons of the District divert ground water from wells primarily for agricultural irrigation purposes.³ Properties of the District’s patrons are located within the Big Lost River basin.

A majority of the District’s patrons were not previously subject to the SWC Call because the farm ground of most of the District’s patrons is located outside of the area of common ground water (“ACGW”) for the ESPA defined in Rule 50 of the CM Rules. On July 1, 2024, a new Idaho statute became effective (Idaho Code § 42-233c) which changed the ACGW boundary to that “described in a model calibration report, eastern Snake plain aquifer model version 2.2. of May 2021.” Idaho Code § 42-233c(1). The new ACGW boundary encompasses depicted on the

By letter, Director Weaver has indicated that he will begin administering water rights under the SWC Call in 2026 for the areas originally outside the CM Rule 50 Boundary, but now within the eastern Snake plain aquifer model version 2.2. of May 2021 boundary.

Further, in March of this year, the Director issued a *Notice of Proposed Action, Public Hearing and Written Comment Period* on March 7, 2025, to “expand the ESPA ACGWS to include the Big Lost tributary basin pursuant to Idaho Code § 42-233c(2).” See <https://idwr.idaho.gov/events/public-hearing-espas-area-of-common-ground-water-supply-proposed-expansion-big-lost-tributary-basin/>. A public meeting was held on March 24, 2025, and written public comments were also submitted. While no order has been issued on the Director’s proposed expansion, it is anticipated that the Director will include the entirety of the Big Lost tributary basin within the ESPA ACGWS subjecting all water ground water rights within the Big Lost tributary basin to priority administration under the CM Rules.

As set forth below, diversion of ground water under the water rights of District patrons, subject to any future curtailment orders under the *Methodology Order*, can be fully mitigated with various actions undertaken by the District. This Plan is being submitted to mitigate the District's impact on the SWC's senior water rights and to avoid any disruption in the operations of the District's patrons.

I. MITIGATION PLAN

CM Rule 43 describes the information that must be contained in a mitigation plan. In accordance with CM Rule 43, the District submits the following information.

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B. Identification of the Water Rights for Which Benefit the Mitigation Plan is Proposed.

Through submission of this plan, it is the District's intent to mitigate all the water rights set forth on **Exhibit 1**.

C. Description of the Plan.

1. Plan Structure.

The District's proposed mitigation plan is structurally consistent with the pumping reductions associated with the approved mitigation plan between IGWA and the SWC.

The District boundaries encompass the entire Big Lost River basin, with irrigated lands from Howell to south of Arco. However, approximately only 80% of these lands are owned or operated by participating patrons of the District. There are 41,324 water right acres currently owned by participating patrons of the District.

The District, under this Plan, proposes to (a) perform groundwater conservation equivalent to that of the IGWA ground water districts; (b) contribute money for the SWC to utilize to lease storage water as an additional supply of water.

The District proposes to perform ground water conservation equivalent to the IGWA participating ground water districts by reducing groundwater diversion by 11.4%, the average pumping reduction required of signatory ground water districts in the IGWA-SWC mitigation plan. The calculated baseline for this reduction will be based on District groundwater diversion amounts from 2013-2015. These years are close to the 2010-2014 baseline used by IGWA and the SWC. While ground water usage data has been collected within Water District 34 for many years, ground water diversion measurements were incomplete before 2013, which is the year when IDWR first required measuring devices on every ground water diversion in this basin. Therefore, records of ground water use prior to 2013 do not provide a reliable representative baseline. Additionally, the 2013 irrigation season was exceptionally dry, the 2014 season was exceptionally wet at the end of the season, and the 2015 season was above average with a wet spring. Collectively, these years adequately represent average climatic conditions and, therefore, average ground water diversions.

The following numbers represent the most accurate data available at this point. From 2013-2015, average groundwater diversions for District members totaled 79,290 acre-feet, equivalent to roughly 1.9 acre-feet of ground water pumping per ground water right acre. The proposed 11.4% reduction equates to a ground water diversion reduction of 9,039 acre-feet. This

results in a total annual allocation of groundwater diversion volume to District patrons of 70,251 acre-feet. As additional water users join the District, the additional user's historic pumping (2013-2015) will be added into both the baseline and reduction calculations, which the District will update each year.

The District will further provide any and all data and information of the type required by the settlement agreement between IGWA and the SWC.

In addition to the pumping reductions described above, as a component to the Plan, the District proposes paying \$50,000 to the SWC by April 1st every year this Plan is in effect for the SWC to utilize for lease of storage water for the SWC's desired purposes (which we anticipate will be primarily for direct delivery for irrigation). The farm ground in the Big Lost River basin is high in elevation, is subject to a shorter growing season, and exists in an economically depressed area of Idaho. It is not on the same economic or competitive footing as members of the SWC. Further, the Big Lost River is not a tributary to the main stem of the Snake River and its water users have no existing lease relationship with storage water spaceholders that would provide a reliable ability to lease storage water. Conversely, the SWC members are all spaceholders and enjoy long-standing existing relationships among themselves and with other irrigation entity spaceholders that places them in a much better position to lease storage water at an economically reasonable price.

II. REQUEST FOR RELIEF

The District hereby requests that the Director:

1. Advertise the Plan as required under the CM Rules;
2. If necessary, hold a hearing regarding this Plan pursuant to CM Rule 43.02; and
3. Enter an order approving the Plan upon such terms and conditions as may be reasonable and necessary to comply with CMR 43.
