Idaho Code § 42-233c(2) authorizes the Director ("Director") of the Idaho Department of Water Resources ("Department") to expand the Eastern Snake Plain Aquifer ("ESPA") Area of Common Ground Water Supply ("ACGWS") to include tributary basins that affect the ESPA. Consumptive use of ground water and surface water in basins tributary to the ESPA reduces inflow to the ESPA and Snake River and therefore, reduces the water supply needed by senior surface water users reliant on the Snake River and springs emerging from the ESPA.

Due to the impact of ground water use in ESPA tributary basins on senior surface water users, the Director proposes to expand the ESPA ACGWS to include the American Falls tributary basin pursuant to Idaho Code § 42-233c(2). Attachment A of this notice is a map showing the American Falls tributary basin in blue, all other ESPA tributary basins in tan, and the current ESPA ACGWS boundary as a green line. 


