Idaho Code § 42-233c(2) authorizes the Director ("Director") of the Idaho Department of Water Resources ("Department") to expand the Eastern Snake Plain Aquifer ("ESPA") Area of Common Ground Water Supply ("ACGWS") to include tributary basins that affect the ESPA.

The Department is hosting a Public Hearing on the proposed action to expand the ESPA ACGWS to include tributary basins that affect the ESPA, as described in the enclosed notice. You are receiving this notice because you are listed as the current owner of a ground water right located within a tributary basin proposed to be included in the ESPA ACGWS.

During the hearing the Department will present information about the proposal to expand the ESPA ACGWS to include tributary basins. The Department will consider testimony presented at the hearing and timely submitted written comments to determine whether the proposed expansion of the ESPA AGCWS into tributary basins is appropriate.

IDWR CAN NOT EXPAND THE ESPA TO INCLUDE TRIBUTARYS

Water Resources ("Department") to expand the Eastern Snake Plain Aquifer ("ESPA") Area of Common Ground Water Supply ("ACGWS") to include tributary basins that affect the ESPA.

Consumptive use of ground water and surface water in basins tributary to the ESPA reduces inflow to the ESPA and Snake River and therefore, reduces the water supply needed by senior surface water users reliant on the Snake River and springs emerging from the ESPA.

Due to the impact of ground water use in ESPA tributary basins on senior surface water users, the Director proposes to expand the ESPA ACGWS to include the American Falls tributary basin pursuant to Idaho Code § 42-233c(2). Attachment A of this notice is a map showing the American Falls tributary basin in blue, all other ESPA tributary basins in tan, and the current ESPA ACGWS boundary as a green line. Non-exempt ground water rights in the American Falls tributary basin will be subject to priority administration associated with delivery calls connected to the ESPA ACGWS.

These include domestic and stock water uses associated with single family residences where the total daily ground water use is ≤13,000 gallons per day and the total lawn irrigation is ≤0.5 acres. Exempt ground water rights also include those administered by the Shoshone-Bannock Tribes and the United States pursuant to the 1990 Fort Hall Indian Water Rights Agreement.


