 NOTICE OF ORDER GRANTING REQUEST FOR HEARING
 ON MORATORIUM**

Notice is hereby given that the Idaho Department of Water Resources (IDWR) signed an Order Granting Request for Hearing on the duration of the Boise Front Low Temperature Geothermal Resource Ground Water Management Area moratorium. On May 3, 2024, IDWR signed an order extending the Boise Front Low Temperature Geothermal Resource Ground Water Management Area moratorium. The moratorium prohibits approval of applications to appropriate water and limits development under the existing permits to divert and use water in the low temperature (75 to 212) geothermal groundwater system lying within Townships 2, 3, and 4 North and Ranges 1, 2, and 3 East in Ada County. On May 17, 2024, IDWR received a petition for hearing regarding the basis for the three-year duration of the moratorium extension. Any person that wants to intervene in the proceeding must file a written petition to intervene with IDWR by September 23, 2024. Any person that wants to participate in the proceeding as a public witness at the hearing should also notify IDWR by September 23, 2024. A petition to intervene or a request to participate as a public witness must be filed with the Idaho Department of Water Resources, State Office, 322 E Front St., 6th floor or by mailing to PO Box 83720, Boise, ID, 83720-0098 or emailing as pdf attachment to file@idwr.idaho.gov. 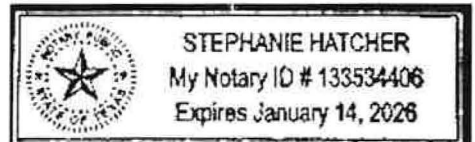
