Dear Parties,

Paragraph 22 of the Fifth Methodology lists the number of irrigated acres in the shapefile for Milner as 13,264 acres, and the number of irrigated acres for Minidoka as 77,176 acres. These numbers are correct. On May 5, 2023, the Department provided the parties, and posted to our publicly available website, a variety information that Jennifer Sukow and Matt Anders may rely on at the June 6-10 hearing. Included in that information were the Milner and Minidoka shape files. It has come to the Department's attention that the Department inadvertently provided Milner and Minidoka's 2022 shapefiles—not the 2023 shapefiles. The Department apologizes for the oversight. Attached to this email are the 2023 shapefiles for Milner and Minidoka. The Director anticipates taking official notice of these files at the hearing.
