The Director of the Department of Water Resources (“Director” or “Department”) hereby notifies the parties to the above captioned delivery call proceeding that a prehearing conference will be held on **Thursday, the 19th day of January, 2012, at 10:00 a.m.**, in the Director’s conference room at the Department’s state office located at 322 E. Front Street, Boise, Idaho.

All parties to the matter must be represented at the conference in person or by telephone. If participating by telephone, please dial 215-446-0193 and provide participant code 275568#.

The parties at the prehearing conference shall: (1) identify the issues they anticipate raising at the hearing to be conducted in this matter; (2) present proposed prehearing schedules identifying time limits to file and hear motions, complete any authorized discovery, simplify issues, identify witnesses, exchange exhibits, hold a final prehearing conference, and address other matters as appropriate; (3) identify dates and an estimated length of time for the hearing; (4) address the potential for utilizing evidence taken at hearing in multiple related proceedings; (5) address ways to avoid unnecessary proof of submission of cumulative evidence; and (6) such other matters as will expedite the disposition of the case. The parties are encouraged to coordinate prehearing schedules prior to the conference. The Director also notes that Rangan, in its delivery call, states that Eastern Snake Plain Aquifer Model (“ESPAM”) version 2.0 should be used in this proceeding. The Eastern Snake Hydrologic Modeling Committee (“ESHMC”), the technical committee tasked with updating the ESPAM model, has not completed its work on ESPAM version 2.0. The parties should come prepared to discuss what effect this has on Rangen’s delivery call.

The conference will be conducted in accordance with the accessibility requirements of the Americans with Disabilities Act. If you require special accommodations in order to attend, participate in or understand the conference, please advise the Department within five (5) days prior to the conference. 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
