NOTICE OF MITIGATION PLAN SUBMITTED BY THE COALITION OF CITIES IN RESPONSE TO THE RANGEN, INC. WATER DELIVERY CALL

Notice is hereby given that on April 25, 2014, the Coalition of Cities ("Coalition"), through its counsel, Robert E. Williams, Candice McHugh and Chris M. Bromley c/o Robert Williams, Williams, Meservy & Lothspeich, LLP, PO Box 168, Jerome ID 83338, and on behalf of its member cities of Bliss, Burley, Carey, Declo, Dietrich, Gooding, Hazelton, Heyburn, Jerome, Paul, Richfield, Rupert and Wendell, submitted the Coalition's Mitigation Plan ("plan" or "mitigation plan") for the Rangen Inc. Delivery Call ("call") to the Idaho Department of Water Resources ("Department"). The Department will process this plan pursuant to the Department's Conjunctive Management Rules (IDAPA 37.03.11).

The plan is intended to satisfy the Coalition's mitigation obligations related to the call as defined in the January 29, 2014, "Final Order Regarding Rangen Inc's Petition For Delivery Call; Curtailing Ground Water Rights Junior to July 13, 1962" and the April 11, 2014, "Order Approving in Part and Rejecting in Part IGWA's Mitigation Plan; Order Lifting Stay Issued February 21, 2014; Amended Curtailment Order" issued by the Director. 20Users%20Calls/Rangen.htm Rangen Inc. ("Rangen") holds water rights for fish propagation from the Martin-Curren Tunnel which is hydrologically connected to the Eastern Snake Plain Aquifer ("ESPA"). The Coalition holds numerous ground water rights for municipal consumptive uses located within the ESPA. Certain of these ground water rights have priority dates junior to the priority dates of rights held by Rangen.

The Coalition has proposed a plan to mitigate injury to Rangen's senior water rights that result from depletions under junior priority ground water rights held by the Coalition. The plan proposes:

Limit the volume diverted by certain cites in the Coalition to only that volume authorized under water rights senior to July 1, 1983; Deliver up to 1.0 cfs or more as necessary and as long as

necessary starting on or before June 1, 2014 to the Sandy Ponds Recharge Area southeast of Hagerman. The water for the ground water recharge will be conveyed to the ponds via the North Side Canal Company's ("NSCC") conveyance system and may be comprised of NSCC shares held by some of the members of the Coalition.

The Department has not determined the adequacy of the proposed plan. A complete copy of the proposed plan is available for review at either the Department's State Office in Boise, the Department's Regional Office in Twin Falls, or at the website link above.

Any protest against approval of the plan must be filed with the Department, together with a protest fee of \$25, within ten days of the last day of publication of this notice.
