ORDER GRANTING REQUEST FOR HEARING; NOTICE OF SCHEDULING CONFERENCE

BACKGROUND

On August 2, 2023, the Director of the Idaho Department of Water Resources ("Department") issued his *Final Order Regarding IGWA's 2022 Mitigation Plan Compliance* ("2022 Compliance Order"). The 2022 Compliance Order determined that Aberdeen-American Falls Ground Water District, Bingham Ground Water District, Bonneville-Jefferson Ground Water District, and Jefferson Clark Ground Water District breached IGWA's 2016 Mitigation Plan during the 2022 irrigation season and would not be entitled to protection under the mitigation plan in response to a curtailment order. *2022 Compliance Order* at 8–9.

On August 16, 2023, A&B Irrigation District, American Falls Reservoir District #2, Burley Irrigation District, Milner Irrigation District, Minidoka Irrigation District, North Side Canal Company, and Twin Falls Canal Company filed *Surface Water Coalition's Petition for Reconsideration and Request for Hearing* ("SWC's Petition) with the Department. The SWC's Petition requests that the Director "reconsider the 2022 Compliance Order and order noncomplying juniors within the four districts to curtail pumping under their junior rights." *SWC's Petition* at 4. In addition, pursuant to Idaho Code § 42-1701A(3), the SWC's Petition requests a hearing on the 2022 Compliance Order. *Id.* at 6.

On August 22, 2023, *IGWA's Response to SWC's Petition for Reconsideration and Request for Hearing* ("IGWA's Response") was filed with the Department. IGWA's Response requests the Director deny the SWC's Petition. *IGWA's Response* at 2.

ANALYSIS AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

Idaho Code § 42-1701A(3) provides in relevant part:

Unless the right to a hearing before the director . . . is otherwise provided in by statute, any person aggrieved by any action of the director, including any decision, determination, order or other action . . . who is aggrieved by the action of the director, and who has not previously been afforded an opportunity for a hearing on the matter shall be entitled to a hearing before the director to contest the action.

The parties have not previously been afforded an opportunity for a hearing on the 2022 Compliance Order and are entitled to a hearing pursuant to Idaho Code § 42-1701A(3). The Director will grant the hearing request and set a scheduling conference in the matter.¹

NOTICE OF SCHEDULING CONFERENCE

The Director hereby notifies the parties that a scheduling conference in this matter will be held on **November 7, 2023, at 9:30 a.m. (MST)**, at the Department's State Office, located at 322 E. Front Street, 6th Floor, Conference Rooms 602C–D, Boise, Idaho. The Department has not yet assigned a hearing officer to the matter. Notice of hearing officer assignment will be provided to the parties prior to the scheduling conference.

The parties to the matter must be represented at the scheduling conference in person or by video conference. The purpose of the conference is to schedule a hearing on the Department's 2022 Compliance Order.
