NOTICE OF PREHEARING CONFERENCE AND HEARING

BACKGROUND

On August 2, 2023, the Director of the Idaho Department of Water Resources issued his Final Order Regarding IGWA's 2022 Mitigation Plan Compliance ("2022 Compliance Order"). On August 16, 2023, A&B Irrigation District, American Falls Reservoir District #2, Burley Irrigation District, Milner Irrigation District, Minidoka Irrigation District, North Side Canal Company, and Twin Falls Canal Company (collectively "Surface Water Coalition") filed Surface Water Coalition's Petition for Reconsideration and Request for Hearing ("SWC's Petition") with the Department. The SWC's Petition requested a hearing on the 2022 Compliance Order pursuant to Idaho Code § 42-1701A(3). SWC's Petition at 6.

On September 6, 2023, the Director issued an *Order Granting Request for Hearing; Notice of Scheduling Conference*. On November 7, 2023, an initial scheduling conference was held by the Director and continued to December 12, 2023.

On December 12, 2023, the Director issued an order appointing Roger S. Burdick as the independent hearing officer in this matter and held a continued scheduling conference. On December 14, 2023, Hearing Officer Burdick issued a *Notice of Second Continued Scheduling Conference; Order Setting Deadlines* ("*Notice/Order*"). The order set deadlines for the parties "to file with the Department a written statement of proposed issues for hearing" and "to file a response to the statements of proposed issues." *Notice/Order* at 3.

On December 27, 2023, all persons identified on the attached certificate of service were informed via email that attendance at the next scheduling conference would be mandatory for anyone wishing to participate as a party in the contested case. A second continued scheduling conference was held on December 28, 2023. During the scheduling conference, after some

discussion occurred and no objections were raised, Hearing Officer Burdick granted American Falls-Aberdeen Ground Water District's pending petition to intervene. For the record, the parties to the contested case were recognized as the Surface Water Coalition, Idaho Ground Water Appropriators, Inc., Bingham Ground Water District, Bonneville-Jefferson Ground Water District, and American Falls-Aberdeen Ground Water District. Hearing Officer Burdick provided notice that any additional petitions to intervene needed to be filed by 5 p.m. on December 28, 2023, to be considered timely. During the scheduling conference, having reviewed the parties' proposed hearing issue statements and responses, Hearing Officer Burdick identified the issues for hearing, established a hearing schedule, and authorized the parties to conduct and engage in discovery.

On December 28, 2023, the Coalition of Cities' and City of Pocatello's Petition to Intervene was timely filed.

ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the parties are authorized to conduct and engage in discovery pursuant to IDAPA 37.01.01.521 as of December 28, 2023.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the following schedule is ADOPTED:

Jan. 8, 2024	Deadline for the parties to serve written discovery requests (interrogatories, requests for production, and requests for admission).
Jan. 22, 2024	Deadline for the parties to serve answers to discovery.
Jan. 31, 2024	Deadline for the parties to file a list of expert witnesses they intend to rely upon at the hearing, including names, addresses, and updated curricula vitarum. Deadline for the parties to submit a list of lay witnesses they intend to rely upon at the hearing, including names, addresses, and a brief summary of their scope of testimony.
Feb. 12, 2024	Deadline for the parties to file dispositive motions. Responses to dispositive motions are due within 14 days of the service date of a motion. Replies to responses will not be allowed.

Feb. 26, 2024 Deadline for the parties to file a list of exhibits they intend to rely upon at the hearing. If any of the parties wish to propose joint/common exhibits, that should be reflected in their list of exhibits. The parties shall use the following reserved exhibit numbers:

Deadline for the parties to file expert reports. If a party intends to have an expert testify during the hearing, the expert needs to have authored a

Deadline for the parties to file rebuttal expert reports and file a list of rebuttal expert witnesses they intend to rely upon at the hearing, including names, addresses, and updated curricula vitarum.

Mar. 6, 2024

Deadline for the parties to exchange and submit to the Department an electronic copy (via e-file email, USB thumb drive, or disc(s)) of their premarked, proposed exhibits. Each exhibit must be an independent document and all PDFs should be machine readable. Exhibits shall be premarked in the bottom right corner of every page and must include: 1) the name of the party proposing the exhibit; 2) the exhibit number; and 3) a page number (each exhibit shall start with page 1).

Mar. 11, 2024

Prior to the start of the hearing, the parties shall submit to the Department three physical copies of their pre-marked, proposed hearing exhibits. Exhibits shall be organized in binders that are labeled with the party's name and include dividers that identify each exhibit by their number.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that, pursuant to IDAPA 37.01.01.051 and due to the impending discovery deadlines outlined in the above scheduling order, IDAPA 37.01.01.354 shall be suspended as it relates to the *Coalition of Cities' and City of Pocatello's Petition to Intervene*. Any party opposing the *Coalition of Cities' and City of Pocatello's Petition to Intervene* must file an objection by January 2, 2024. Responses to the objection must be filed by January 4, 2024.

- 1) Did the Director error by not issuing an order specifying the actions needed to cure the 2022 breach of the 2016 Mitigation Plan¹ by certain ground water districts?
- 2) Did the Director error by not immediately issuing an order curtailing ground water districts that breached the 2016 Mitigation Plan in 2022?
- 3) Can the 2009 mitigation plan be used to cure the ground water districts' 2022 breach of the 2016 Mitigation Plan?
- 4) What action must be taken by the ground water districts to cure their 2022 breach of the 2016 Mitigation Plan?
