NOTICE OF MITIGATION PLAN SUBMITTED BY MADISON GROUND WATER DISTRICT AND HENRY'S FORK GROUND WATER DISTRICT IN RESPONSE TO THE SURFACE WATER COALITION WATER DELIVERY CALL

Notice is hereby given that, on December 18, 2023, Madison Ground Water District and Henry's Fork Ground Water District ("MHFGWDs" or "GWDs"), through their counsel Jerry R. Rigby, PO Box 250, Rexburg, ID 83440, and on behalf of the GWDs' members, submitted the Petition for Approval of Madison Ground Water District and Henry's Fork Ground Water District's Storage Water Mitigation Plan for the Surface Water Coalition ("Mitigation Plan" or "Plan") to the Idaho Department of Water Resources ("Department").

The Plan is intended to satisfy the mitigation obligations of the GWDs for the Surface Water Coalition ("SWC") Water Delivery Call administered by the Department and watermasters of state water districts who administer ground water rights within the Eastern Snake Plain Aquifer ("ESPA"). The SWC consists of irrigation water delivery entities that hold senior surface water rights diverted from the Snake River above Milner Dam. The SWC members include A&B Irrigation District, American Falls Reservoir District #2, Burley Irrigation District, Milner Irrigation District, Minidoka Irrigation District, North Side Canal Company, and Twin Falls Canal Company. MHFGWDs represent members who hold ground water rights within a portion of the ESPA that are junior in priority to the SWC's senior priority Snake River water rights.

The GWDs propose to offset the amount of water the SWC would receive from curtailment of ground water rights held by members of MHFGWDs by 1) annual delivery or assignment of 1,500 acre-feet of storage water to the SWC members from reservoirs in the Water District 1 reservoir system, and 2) recharge, on an average annual basis, of 3,000 acre-feet of water in the Henry's Fork basin. If this provides less water to the SWC than is required to fully offset the amount of water the SWC would receive from curtailment of ground water rights held by members of the GWDs, the GWDs will secure and assign storage to the SWC members or recharge such further volume of water as may be required by the Department.

The Plan proposes that if the GWDs secure and deliver less storage than is required to fully offset the amount of water the SWC would receive from curtailment of ground water rights held by the GWDs' members, the GWDs may be subject to curtailment to make up the shortfall, unless the GWDs provide mitigation under another approved mitigation plan.

The Department will process the Plan pursuant to the Department's Conjunctive Management Rules (IDAPA 37.03.11). A complete copy of the Mitigation Plan is available for review at either the Department's State Office in Boise, the Department's Regional Offices in Twin Falls and Idaho Falls, or at the following website link: <https://idwr.idaho.gov/legal-actions/delivery-call-actions/swc/mgwd-hfgwd/>.

The Department has not determined the adequacy of the Mitigation Plan. Any protest against approval of the Mitigation Plan must be filed with the Department, together with a protest fee of \$25, on or before **February 5, 2024**. Rule 53 of the Department's Rules of Procedure (IDAPA 37.01.01.053) outlines how documents may be filed with the Department and when they are considered filed. The protest must include a certificate of service showing that a copy of the protest has been mailed or delivered personally to counsel for MHFGWDs.
