Re: Proposed Change to Conjunctive Management Rule 50

Dear Richard:

I oppose the inclusion of Basins 33 & 34 in the change to Rule #50 by IDWR as proposed by Clear Springs Foods, Inc. The Big and Little Lost Rivers and the Snake River are quite clearly separated on a real time basis and as such makes calls for water outside our basin pointless and unmanageable: Pointless because the volume of water from the Big Lost compared to the Snake River is statistically insignificant; unmanageable because there is no delivery system for immediate availability of water to out of Basin users. In addition, how would or could you administer calls for water from Basin 33 & 34 to Snake River users.

The proposed change to Rule #50 to include Basins 33 & 34 is wrong and misguided and I am totally opposed.
