

I know that the state doesn't won't to be the bad guys, but when you build a highway or a dam that is for the benefit of the majority of the people the state buys the land that is affected at a fair market value price. Why can't the state buy out the spring users, it is definitely the best economical decision for the State Of Idaho and it's citizens,
