**PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OF
ORDER APPROVING DAIRYMEN'S AND
IGWA'S 2007 REPLACEMENT WATER
PLANS, RESCINDING 2007
CURTAILMENT, AND SETTING
HEARING AND PREHEARING SCHEDULE**

The Idaho Dairymen's Association (the "Dairymen") through their attorneys Givens Pursley LLP, and pursuant to Department Rule of Procedure 770, IDAPA 37.01.01.770, hereby petitions for clarification and reconsideration of the Department's July 5, 2007 Orders ("July 5 Orders") in the above-captioned delivery call matters. The grounds for this Petition are that both of the July 5 Orders appear to misapprehend the nature and extent of mitigation proposed by the

Dairymen and contemplated by the parties to the Mitigation Agreement (“Agreement”) submitted for the Department’s approval on April 13, 2007. The July 5 Orders also mischaracterize the Dairymen’s commitments under the Agreement and do not appear to incorporate the mitigation obligations or contributions of ground water users other than the Dairymen and Idaho Ground Water Appropriators, Inc.’s (“IGWA”) in analyzing the sufficiency of mitigation for 2007. Consequently, the Order purports to require from the Dairymen replacement water in 2007 that will exceed their mitigation obligation under existing law and the Agreement.

Also, clarification is requested to confirm whether, and to what extent, the mitigation obligations of other ground water users (i.e., non-ground water district members such as certain commercial, industrial and municipal water users, and domestic well owners who, under the holding of both the District Court and the Idaho Supreme Court in *AFRD No. 2 v. IDWR*, are subject to conjunctive administration) are incorporated into the total mitigation/replacement water supply for 2007 so as not to impose a disproportionate obligation on the Dairymen.

A hearing on the above issues is requested.

I. BACKGROUND

A. The Mitigation Agreement.

In April of this year, following extended negotiations, the Dairymen, members of the Surface Water Coalition (“SWC”), Clear Springs Foods and the Thousand Springs Water Users Association (“TSWUA”) executed the Mitigation Agreement, by which the Dairymen proposed to: 1) offset the aggregate annual depletion to the ESPA; 2) attributable to ground water diversions under commercial livestock water rights; 3) held by those of the Dairymen’s members who elected to participate in the Agreement; 4) on the basis of 29.1 gallons per mature dairy cow per day (10,621.5 gallons per year).

Under the Agreement, the offset of the participating Dairymen members' aggregate annual depletion is to be provided by use of Mitigation Acres/Mitigation Water Rights (dry-up) or replacement water obtained through the WD 01 rental pool and/or North Side Canal Company. In any case, the quantity of dry-up or replacement water to be provided is directly related to the number of mature cows held by each of the *participating* Dairymen members, not the number of mature cows held by *all* of the Dairymen's members. The potential that under the Agreement the Dairymen would mitigate for depletions attributable to all dairy cows on the ESPA at a rate of 29.1 gpd (i.e., where all of the Dairymen's members elected to participate) gives rise to a potential total mitigation obligation approaching 9,500 acre-feet. Under the Agreement, the Dairymen represented it would *recommend* participation in the Agreement by each of its members located on the ESPA, not that all members would participate which could require mitigation at a 9,000+ acre-foot per year level.

B. The Department's June 15 Curtailment Orders.

On June 15, 2007, the Department issued Curtailment Orders in the above-captioned delivery calls ("June 15 Orders"). Both of the June 15 Orders apply to specific ground water rights with specific priority dates within a delineated curtailment area. Neither of the June 15 Orders purported to require curtailment of ground water use by, or mitigation from, Dairymen members whose facilities, water rights and points of diversion were outside the curtailment areas.

The Orders also conditionally approved the Agreement and stated that Dairymen members who signed the Agreement by July 6, 2007 would not be subject to curtailment unless the Director determined that the mitigation actions proposed by the Agreement were insufficient

to mitigate for the participating Dairymen members' depletions to the ESPA in the third year of a five-year phased-in substitute curtailment period.

C. Participating Dairymen.

On July 3, 2007 the Dairymen provided the Department with additional requested information concerning the basis for the 29.1 gpd depletion quantity used in the Agreement, together with a Statement of Participation listing Dairymen member signators who had indicated their intent to be participating members under the Agreement. This list was supplemented on July 6th. Their understanding, and commitment, in signing the Statement of Participation was to participate in the Agreement in 2007 by way of funding the acquisition of replacement water to offset depletions to the ESPA attributable to their individual dairy operations at the 29.1 gpd per mature cow rate contained in the Agreement.

Also on July 3rd, Jack Davis, as the Dairymen's president, notified the Department that he was electing participation in the Agreement on behalf of those Dairymen members who held junior rights in the curtailment areas subject to the Curtailment Orders that had not been able to sign the Statement of Participation. Mr. Davis's letter stated, among other things, that provided the Mitigation Agreement is approved by the Department as required by the Agreement's terms, IDA's intent is to obtain sufficient water in 2007 to satisfy the requirements of the Agreement with respect to these members' rights for 2007.

D. The July 5 Orders

The July 5 Orders incorporate additional information provided to the Department by IGWA and the Dairymen subsequent to the June 15 Orders. These orders acknowledge that IGWA has proposed to provide a total of 20,000 acre-feet of water for recharge purposes in 2007 (Finding of Fact 3) and find that the Dairymen have "pledged 9,500 acre-feet of water to be run

through the North Side Canal and associated laterals for purposes of recharge after irrigation of lands serviced by the North Side Canal is complete.” Finding of Fact 4. The orders do not acknowledge the mitigation proposals submitted by the Cities of Paul, Jerome, Shoshone, Wendell and Heyburn. These orders then conclude that “based on acceptance of [the Dairymen’s] pledge for 9,500 acre-feet of water to be used for recharge purposes in 2007 and IGWA’s Replacement Plan and Supplemental Plan for 2007, the Director should rescind [the June 15 Orders]. Conclusion of Law 18.

II. DISCUSSION

- A. The Dairymen have not “pledged” to provide 9,500 acre-feet of water for 2007 mitigation.

The Dairymen have proposed to provide mitigation for 2007 at the level described in the Agreement. Under the Agreement, that level is determined by multiplying the number of mature dairy cows held by participating Dairymen members by 29.1 gpd. Until the Dairymen had obtained signatures indicating member intent to be participating members, the total number of mature dairy cows implicated under the Agreement, and hence the quantity of water to be provided, could not be determined.

Based on Idaho State Department of Agriculture data for 2007, the Dairymen’s member who received curtailment notices hold 122,505 mature dairy cows. The Dairymen’s president, Jack Davis, has effectively elected participation for all of these members at the 29.1 gpd level by his July 3 letter to the Department. This will require 3,993.20 acre-feet of replacement water to be provided under the Agreement for 2007. Based on the *total* signatures obtained by the Dairymen as of July 6th (i.e., including members who did not receive a curtailment notice) and Idaho State Department Agriculture 2007 data, the total number of mature dairy cows implicated

by the signed Statements of Participation is 174,310.¹ At 29.1 gpd, this would equate to a total aggregate depletion (and 2007 replacement water requirement) of 5,681.85 acre-feet. The Dairymen presume that provided the gpd depletion quantity remains at 29.1 for 2007, all those members who have signed the Statement of Participation will continue to participate and the Dairymen would acquire and distribute the approximately 5,682 acre-feet as provided by the Agreement in 2007. However, to the extent that the Department determines the depletion per mature dairy cow should be higher than 29.1 for 2007, the Dairymen cannot represent that all those who have signed the Statement of Participation, particularly those who did not receive a curtailment notice, would participate this year.

To the extent the July 5 Orders conclude that the Dairymen's proposed mitigation is a pledge of 9,500 acre-feet of water in 2007, they mischaracterize the terms of the Agreement and the Statement of Participation submitted to the Department, and they should be modified accordingly.

- B. The July 5 Orders do not account for mitigation proposed to be provided by the mitigating Cities or the lack of mitigation from ground water users who are neither Dairymen, ground water district members or mitigating Cities.

The July 5 Orders contain detailed analysis of the IGWA and Dairymen mitigation proposals, but do not address whether, or to what extent the Dairymen are, individually or collectively, being called on to provide mitigation for persons or entities who are not participating in or contributing to mitigation efforts but that are subject to curtailment orders. As written, these orders do not eliminate the concern that the level of mitigation that might be required of the Dairymen by the Department (i.e., 9,500 acre feet) is potentially providing gratis mitigation for persons or entities that are subject to priority administration, including all uses

recognized as such by the recent *AFRD No. 2 v. IDWR* decision who are not providing their own mitigation together through ground water membership or otherwise. The July 5 Orders should be clarified to confirm that this is not, and will not be, the case.

REQUEST FOR HEARING

To the extent the above requests for reconsideration and for clarification are not granted in their entirety, the Dairymen request a hearing on these issues.

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
