APPLICANT'S NOTICE OF APPEARANCE, OR ALTERNATIVELY, UNOPPOSED MOTION TO INTERVENE PURSUANT TO I.A.R. 7.1 NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, that Robert L. Harris of the firm of Holden, Kidwell, Hahn & Crapo, P.L.L.C. hereby enters an appearance on behalf of the applicants Karl T. Cook and Jeffrey M. Cook (hereinafter collectively the "Applicant") in the above-entitled appeal. This notice is given pursuant to paragraph 3 of the Procedural Order Governing Judicial Review of Final Order of Director of Idaho Department of Water Resources dated July 1, 2015 (the "Procedural Order"). This notice is supported by the Affidavit of Robert L. Harris ("Harris Aff.") submitted contemporaneously herewith.

Paragraph 3 of the *Procedural Order* allows a person who was a party to the underlying administrative proceeding to file a notice of appearance within fourteen (14) days of the date of the *Procedural Order*, which will be treated as a motion to intervene. Counsel for the Applicant was served with the *Notice of Appeal & Petition for Judicial Review* dated June 26, 2015 as evidenced by the certificate of service for the appeal. *Affidavit of Robert L. Harris* ("*Harris Aff.*") at ¶2. However, counsel did not receive and was not listed on the certificate of service of the *Procedural Order*. *Id.* ¶3. Because counsel for the Applicant did not receive a copy of the *Procedural Order*, he did not file this notice of appearance until now.

The *Procedural Order* also provides that "[a] person or entity **not a party** to the underlying administrative proceeding who desires to participate in this action, and is not otherwise a Petitioner, must proceed in accordance with Idaho Appellate Rule 7.1." (emphasis added). Because the Applicant was a party to the underlying administrative proceeding, and was not served with the *Procedural Order*, it is not entirely clear if the Applicant must still proceed under I.A.R. 7.1 or whether the Applicant can simply file a notice of appearance. Nevertheless, in order to cover all avenues, and in the alternative to the notice, the Applicant

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requests that the court consider this notice as a motion to intervene pursuant to Rule 7.1 of the

Idaho Appellate Rules ("I.A.R.").

It is clear that the Applicant has an interest in the above-entitled appeal, and would like to

brief the Applicant's position on the issues raised on appeal. Additionally, counsel for the

Applicant has visited with counsel for the appellant who is handling the appeal for the Surface

Water Coalition and counsel for the Department, and there are no objections to the motion.

Harris Aff. ¶7-8. Therefore, this motion is unopposed. Additionally, the motion will not result

in prejudice to any party because the Applicant will not request a change to the briefing schedule

or the hearing date, and will timely submit a response brief on or before October 14, 2015. Id.

¶10. For these reasons, the Applicant requests that this court grant the motion to intervene

pursuant to I.A.R. 7.1.
