Order Resetting Scheduling Conference

A Scheduling Conference was held on January 4, 2022 but only Meghan Carter for the defense attended. Kahle Becker did not attend. Although he filed a motion to reset the scheduling conference because a counterclaim and jury trial demand were filed after the Stipulation for Scheduling and Planning was filed in this case, Mr. Becker had not contacted the in-court clerk for a hearing date or noticed his motion for hearing.

As explained to Ms. Carter, the Court permits the parties to amend a stipulation for scheduling and planning by agreement of the parties, excluding the trial date and/or the summary judgment deadline which can only be amended by the Court. If the parties cannot reach an agreement for amendment, then a motion must be made with a hearing noticed before the Court.

The Court resets the Scheduling Conference to February 8, 2022 at 2:30 p.m.
