Additionally, the parties requested this Court vacate the April 12, 2022 summary judgment hearing and reset the hearing for Tuesday, April 19, 2022, at 3:15 p.m. Based on the parties *Stipulation and Joint Motion for an Extension of Time to File Briefs and Vacate and Reset Hearing*, the Court reset the Summary Judgment hearing for Tuesday, April 19, 2022, at 3:15 p.m. on I Court, but did not send a written Order to the parties.

On April 5, 2022, Defendant IDWR filed a *Cross Motion for Summary Judgment* and *Opposition to Plaintiff's Motion for Summary Judgment*, a *Statement of Facts in Support of Cross Motion for Summary Judgment and Opposition to Plaintiff's Motion for Summary Judgment*, and a *Memorandum in Support* thereof. Judgment and the Motions Plaintiff desires to file, related thereto, for a hearing on May 10,

2022 at 4:00 p.m. Pursuant to IRCP 7(b)(3) any new motions Plaintiff intends to file must

be filed on or before April 26, 2022. Plaintiff's Motion for Summary Judgment Reply Brief will also be filed on or before April 26, 2022. Defendant's responses to any new motions Plaintiff files are to be filed on or before May 3, 2022. Should Plaintiff desire to file a reply brief to any response brief submitted by Defendant for the other Motions referenced above, Plaintiff's Replies must be filed on or before May 6, 2022.
