² The dates set for trial and any pre-trial conference shall not be changed except by leave of the court upon a showing of good cause. I.R.C.P. 16(a). The dates set for other matters shall not be modified except by leave of the court upon a showing of good cause or by stipulation of all the parties with court approval.



¹ I.R.C.P. 16(a) requires a scheduling conference within 30 days after answer or notice of appearance, or within 90 days after filing of complaint if one or more defendants have been served.

counsels' preferred trial and pre-trial dates. Otherwise. the conference will be held for the purpose of choosing the dates for trial and pretrial conference. Counsel should contact the Court prior to the scheduled conference to determine if the conference is vacated.

Following the scheduling conference or receipt of a scheduling stipulation, the court will enter a scheduling and I.R.C.P. 16(b) pre-trial procedure order.
