DECLARATION OF KRISTINA SOUTHWELL IN SUPPORT OF PLAINTIFF'S OPPOSITION TO DEFENDANT'S MOTION TO ORDER RETURN OF STATE PROPERTY

I, Kristina Southwell, testify as follows:

- 1. I am one of the counsel of record for Plaintiff Strider Construction Co., Inc. in the above-captioned matter. I am over the age of eighteen, competent to testify, and have personal knowledge of the matters herein.
- 2. After exchanging written correspondence with counsel for IWRB (Jennifer Reinhardt-Tessmer) over certain written discovery responses, Ms. Reinhardt-Tessmer and I agreed to hold a

meet and confer conference to discuss the discovery issues. This meet and confer occurred on

March 29, 2023 via a Teams call.

3. In advance of the scheduled meet and confer, I received an email from Ms. Reinhardt-

Tessmer asking whether Strider had retained any samples of the J-seals.

4. During the meet and confer conference on March 29, 2023, I acknowledged receipt of

Ms. Reinhardt-Tessmer's email and confirmed that Strider did in fact have a sample of a piece of

old J-seal and a piece of new J-seal in its possession. I told Ms. Reinhardt-Tessmer that Strider

would make the samples available for inspection and testing by IWRB at a mutually agreeable

time and place, as required by discovery rules, pursuant to (what I assumed) would be a

forthcoming request from IWRB.

5. During the conference I recall Ms. Reinhardt-Tessmer asking where Strider's office was

located and expressing concern over traveling there, to which I indicated that inspection could

occur at some other "mutually agreeable" location. There was no accusation that the sample was

"stolen state property" or any indication that it was not subject to typical discovery procedures.

Attached at Exhibit A is a true and correct copy of the full email thread between myself 6.

and Ms. Reinhardt-Tessmer that ensued after our meet and confer.

Jennifer,

Our position, based on the Contract, is that the J-seal is not state property, and under the discovery rules there is no obligation to give IWRB or your office physical possession of the seal. Strider is preserving the seal, as is its obligation. I have repeatedly offered to discuss finding a mutually agreeable time and place for IWRB to have access to the seal for inspection and testing, which meets Strider's obligations under the discovery rules. For those reasons, a motion by IWRB would be unsuccessful. I'll also point out that there has not been an actual discovery request made for the seal. Nor has IWRB indicated that it has engaged an expert to perform testing.

The appropriate course of action here is for IWRB to make a formal discovery request and discuss a time and place to inspect the seal once it has engaged an expert.
